





# Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 19/08/2020

# HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 265 New Cases and 9 Deaths reported in the last 24 hours
- 254 are local cases and 11 are returnees from South Africa
- 6 Deaths are from Harare Province, 1 Mash Central, 1 Masvingo and 1 Mash West
- Masvingo reports first Covid-19 Death as deaths reach 150
- Active Cases further decline to 1051 today
- 337 total new recoveries reported (Mat South reported 188 recoveries today)
- As of 19 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 5643 Cases 4442 recoveries and 150 Deaths.

















#### Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate


- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend
- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at 2.66% as at 19/8/20






## Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn


## Age and Sex Distribution for Cases


- More males affected when compared to females

## Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths




# **COMMENTS**

- There are more deaths from males as age rises




- Harare had the highest number of tests done per capita today




