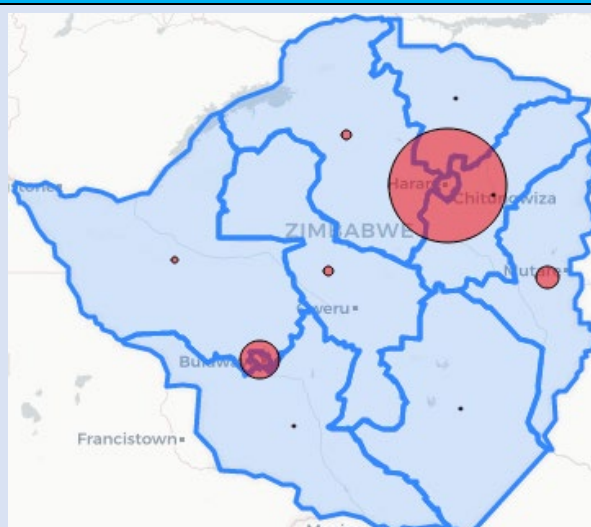
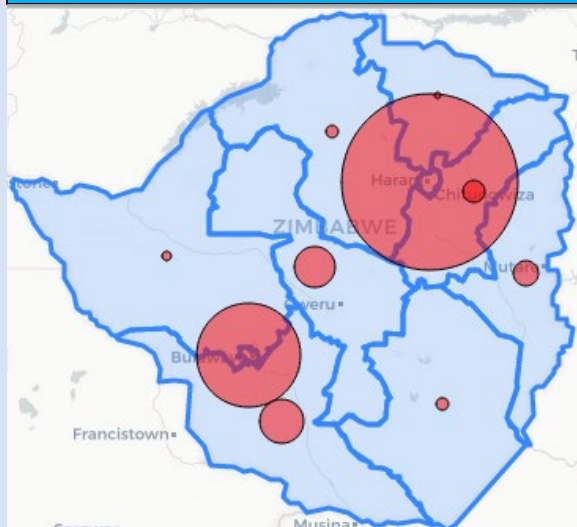


Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 20/08/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

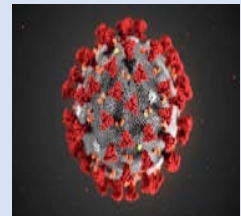
- **102** New Cases and **1** Death reported in the last 24 hours
- **All 102** are local cases
- **1** Death reported from Masvingo Province (The second in successive days)
- Active Cases rise to **1069** today
- **83** total new recoveries reported (Bulawayo reported **59** recoveries today)
- As of 20 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded **5745** Cases **4525** recoveries and **151** Deaths.

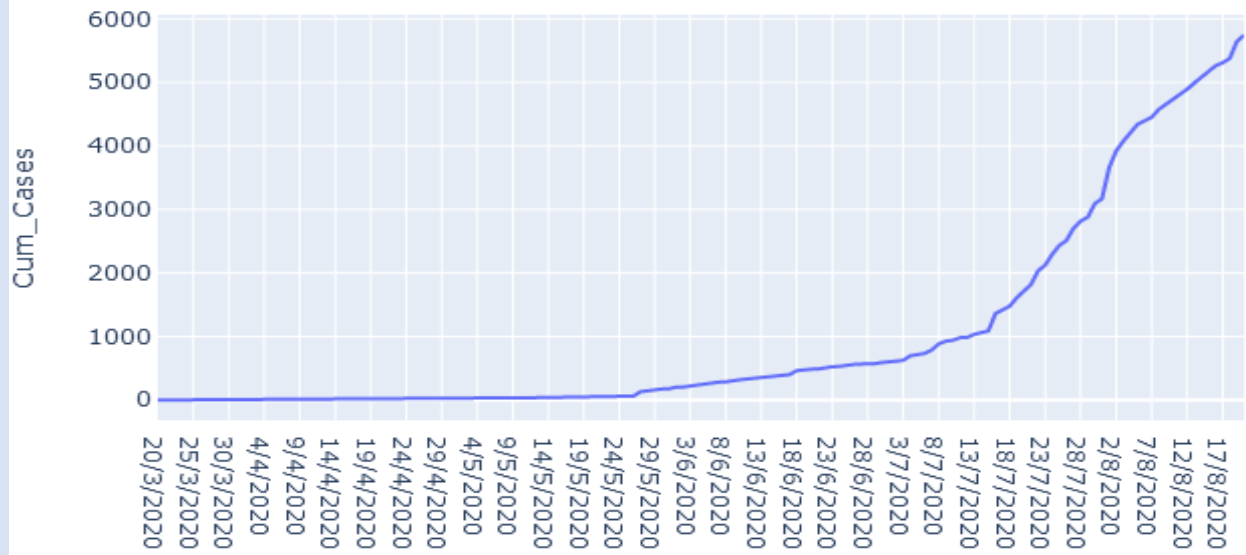

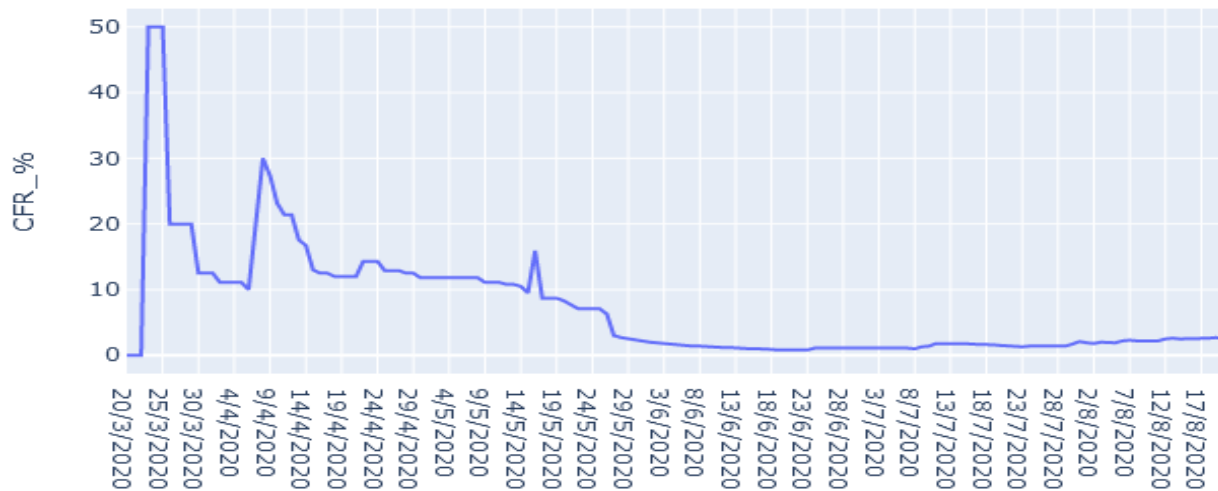

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases

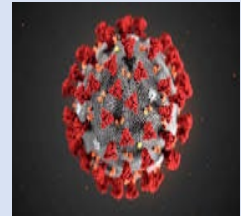


Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



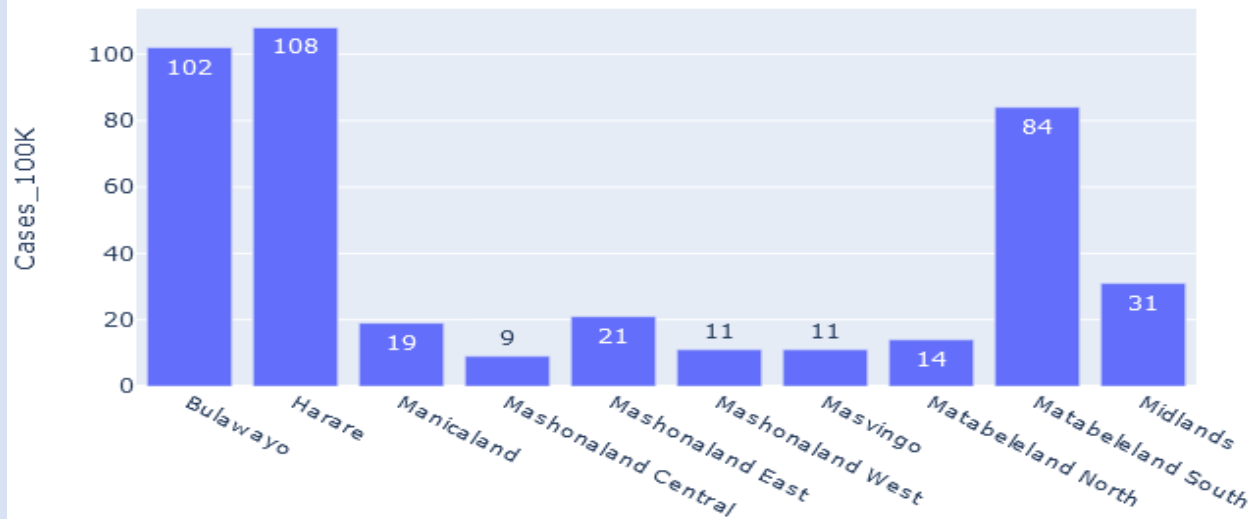
COMMENTS

- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at **2.6%** as at 20/8/20

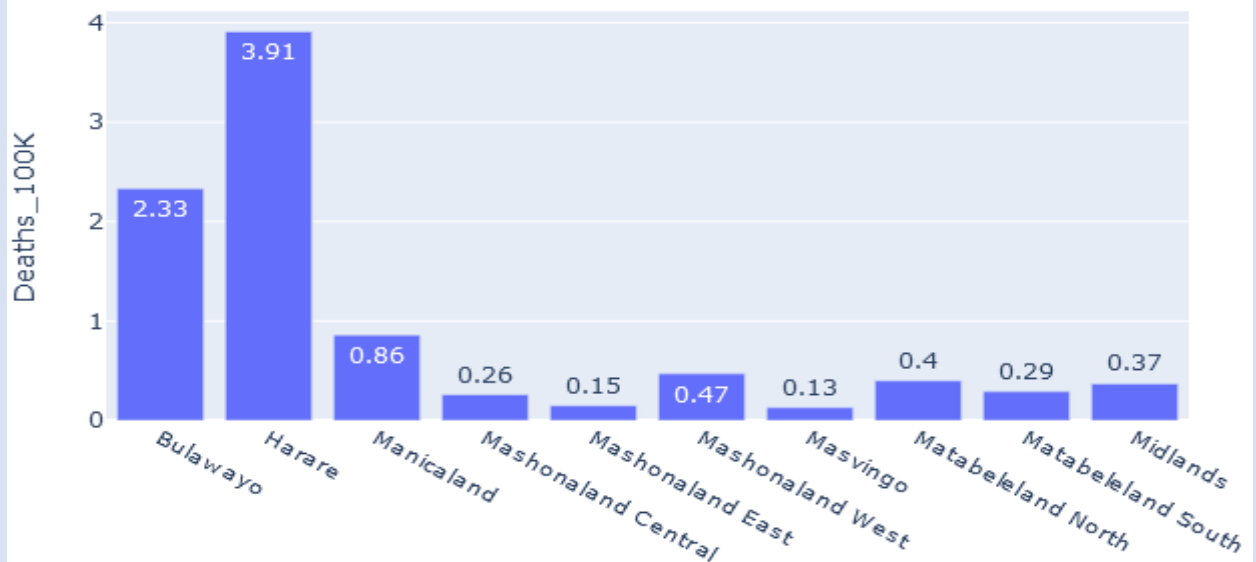

Zimbabwe Covid Cases Per 100K Popn

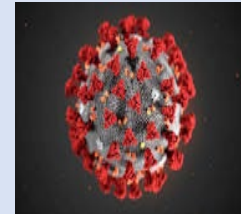


Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn



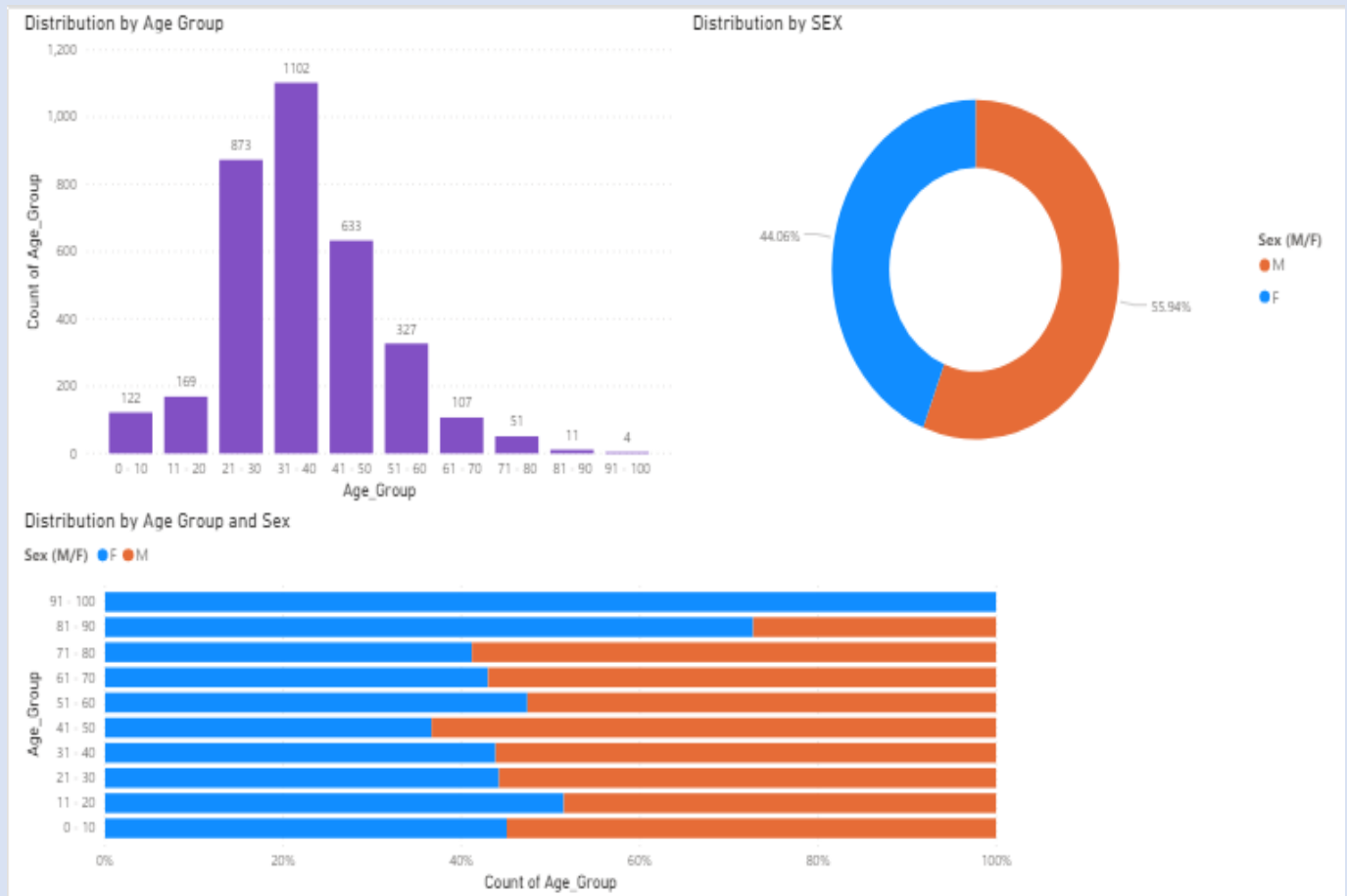
COMMENTS

- Harare has the highest number of deaths per capita followed by Bulawayo



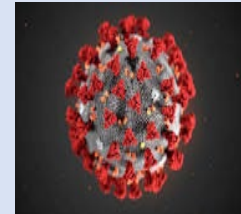
CHARACTERISTICS OF CASES

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



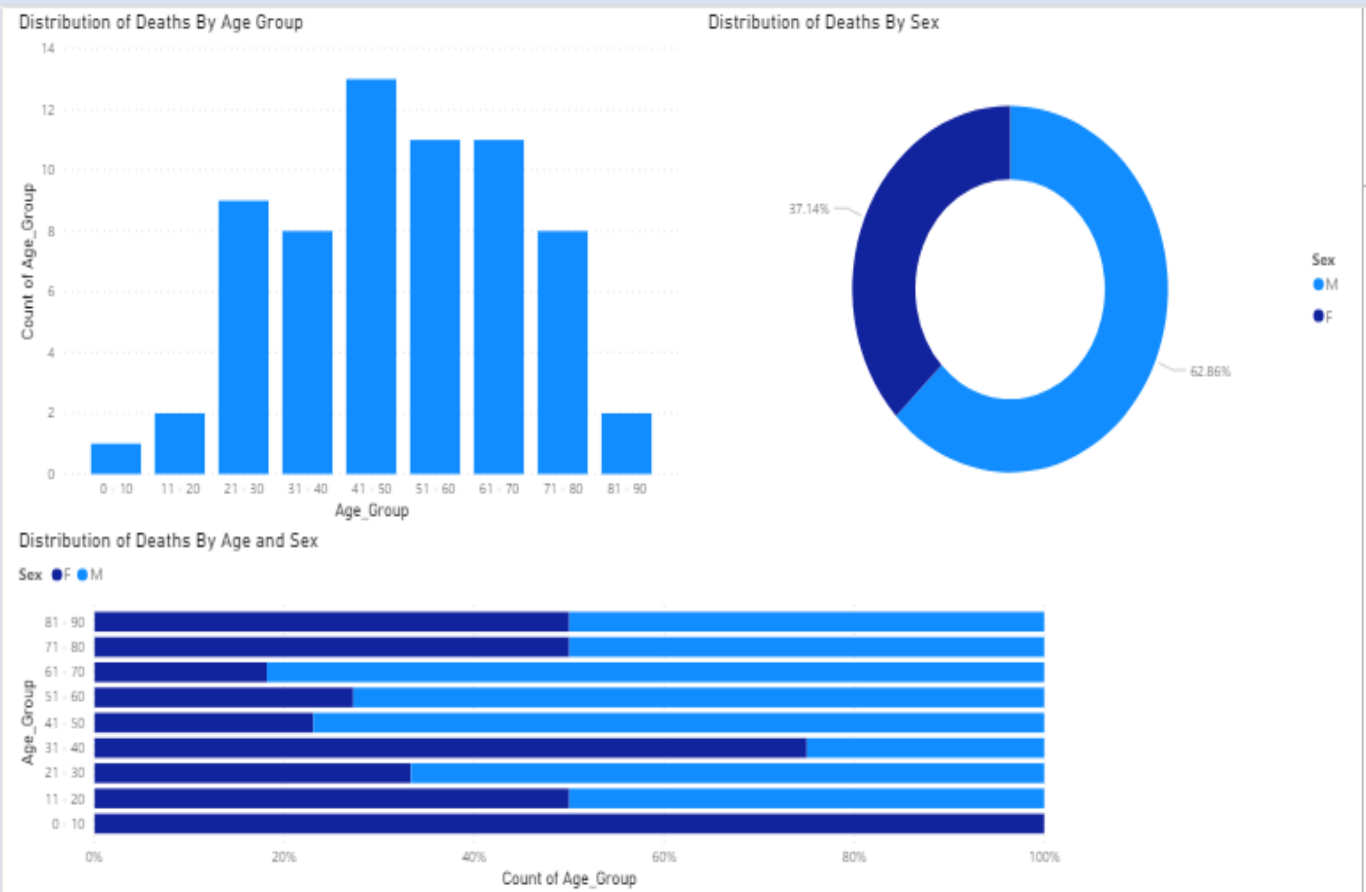
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths

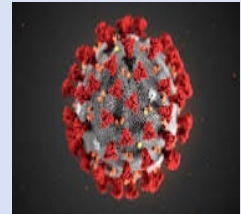

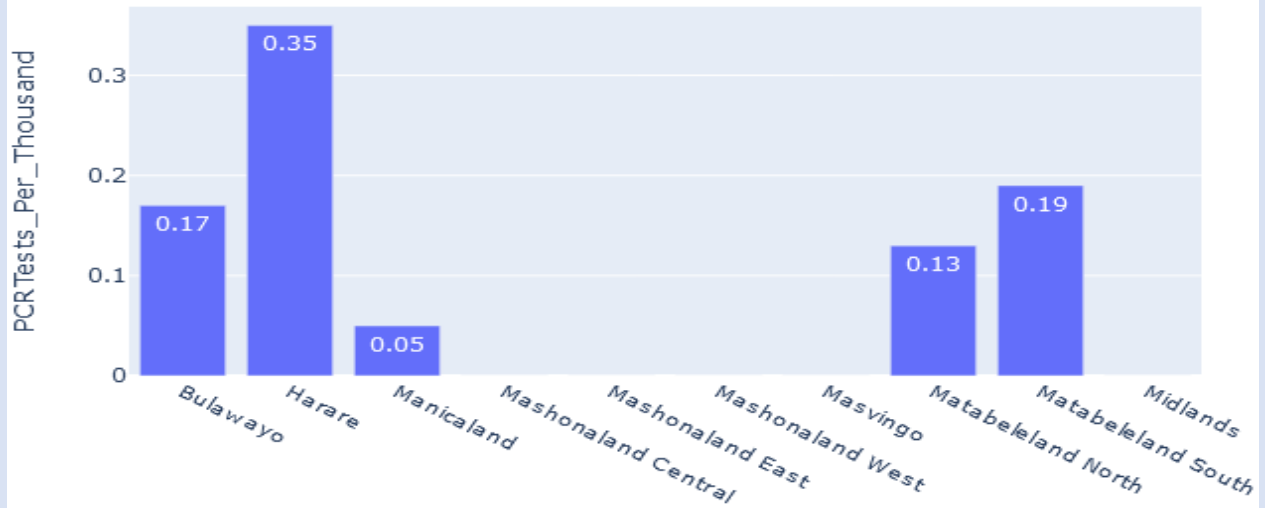
- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age

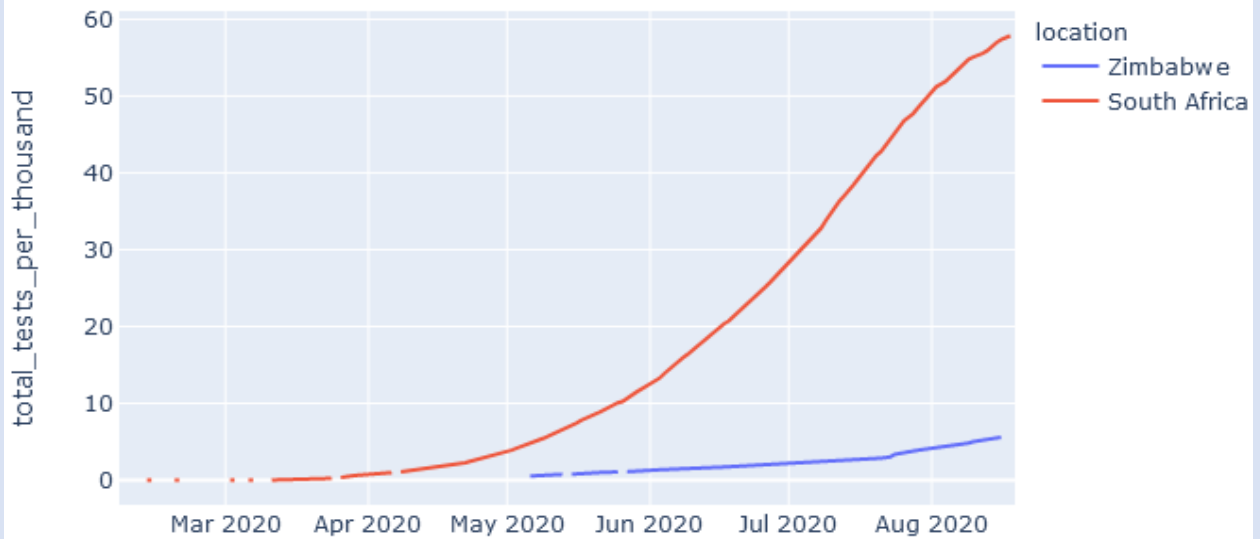


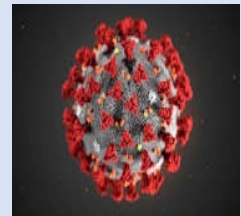
Number of PCR Tests done Per Thousand Population Today



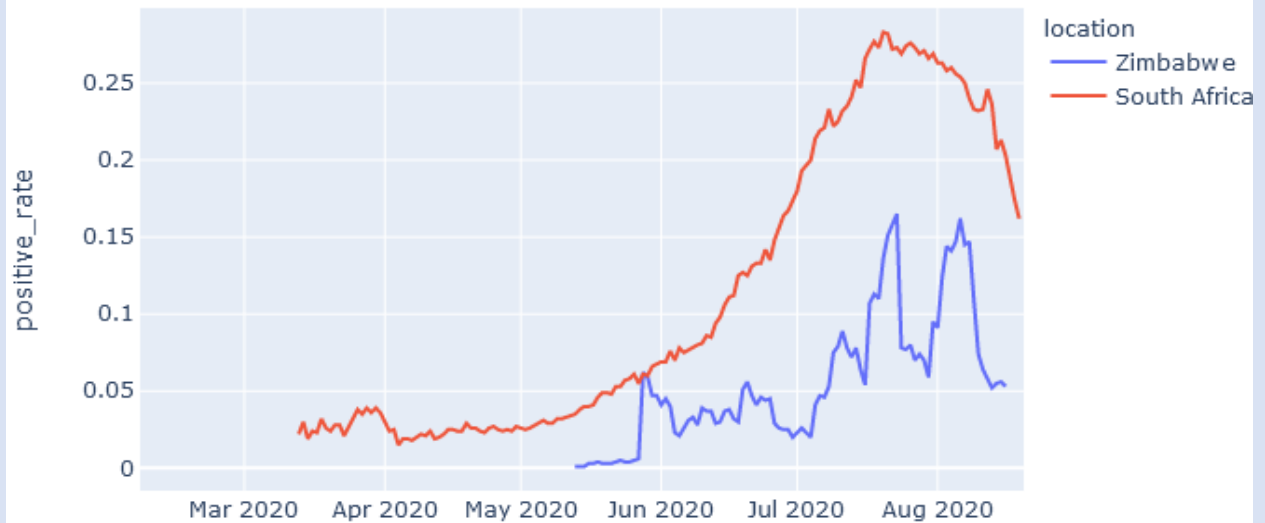

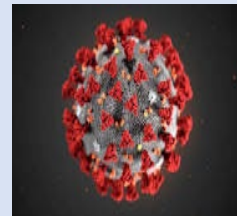
COMMENTS

- **Positivity has decreased to 5.2%**

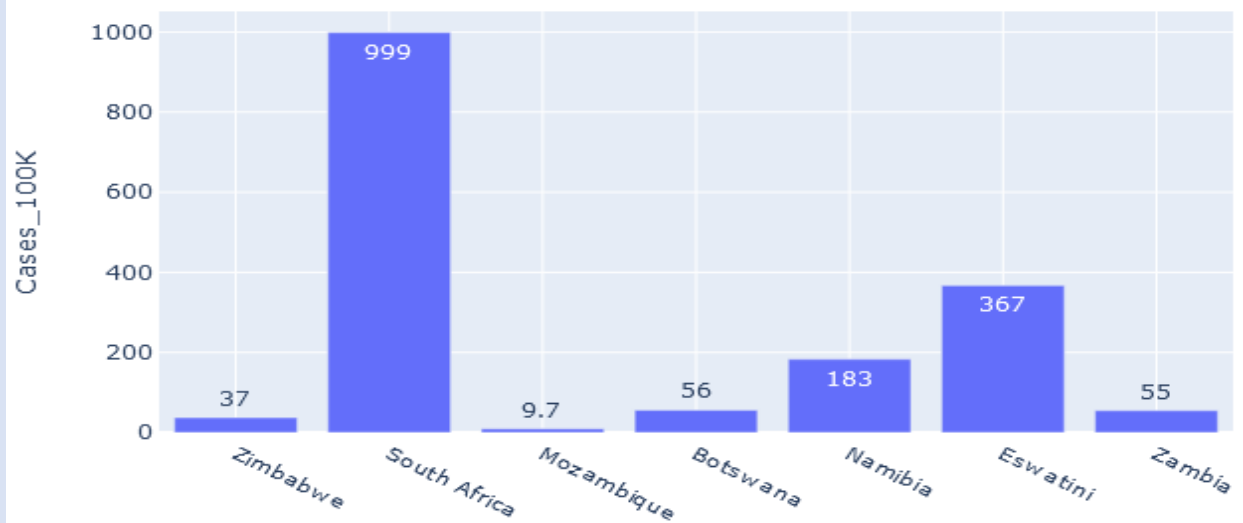

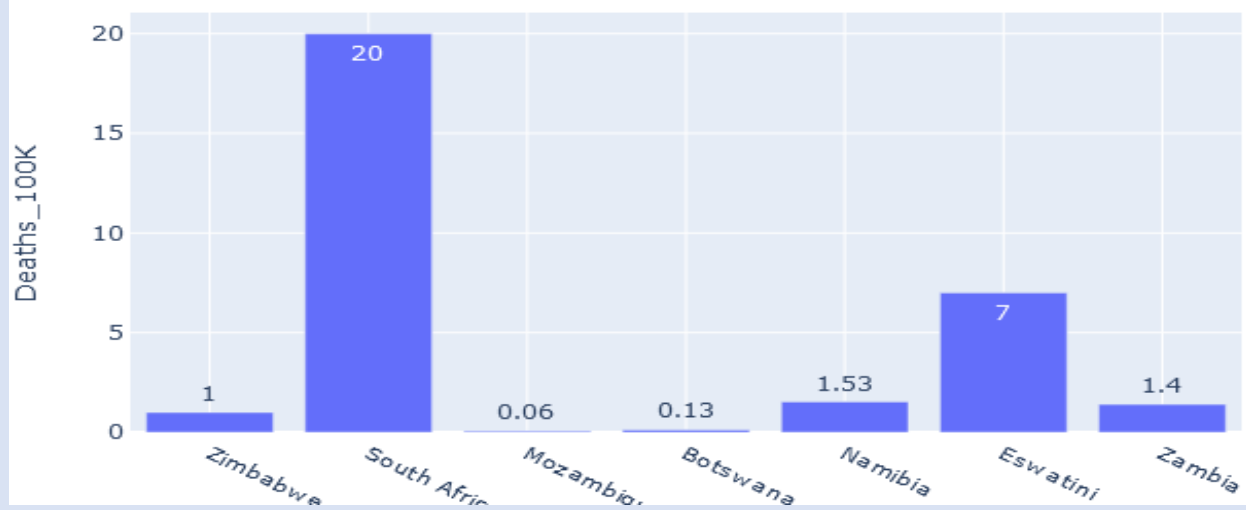
