



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 20/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 11 New Cases and No Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases further goes down to 22 from 23 yesterday).
- 628 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 1.8%)
- All 11 are local cases
- 10 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 77% and Active cases go up to 1534 today
- As of 20 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7683 Cases 5924 recoveries and 225 Deaths.

CASES AND DEATHS DISTRIBUTION









- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend


COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)




