



## Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 21/08/2020

## **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- **70** New Cases and **1** Death reported in the last 24 hours
- All 70 are local cases
- **1** Death reported from Manicaland Province
- Active Cases rise to 1076 today
- 62 total new recoveries reported (Mash East reported 35 recoveries today)
- As of 21 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded **5815** Cases **4587** recoveries and **152** Deaths.







#### CASES AND DEATHS DISTRIBUTION






## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases




## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate


- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend
- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at 2.6% as at 21/8/20











#### COMMENTS

- Harare has the highest number of deaths per capita followed by Bulawayo






#### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases


- More males affected when compared to females

#### Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths




## **COMMENTS**

- There are more deaths from males as age rises









## Number of PCR Tests done Per Thousand Population Today





- Positivity has increased to 8.2% (targeted testing could account for this rise)




