



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 21/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 23 New Cases and 1 Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases further goes up to 25 from 22 yesterday).
- 263 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 8.7%)
- All 23 are local cases (Death reported by Harare Province)
- 24 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 77% and Active cases go down to 1532 today
- As of 21 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7706 Cases 5948 recoveries and 226 Deaths.












COMMENTS

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at 2.9 % as at 21/9/20








COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)




