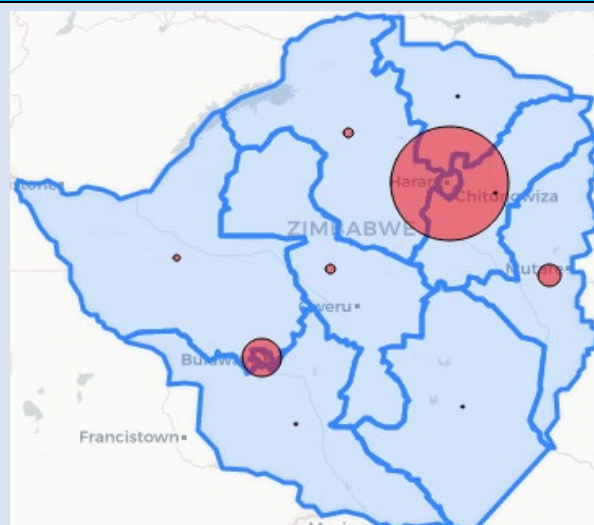
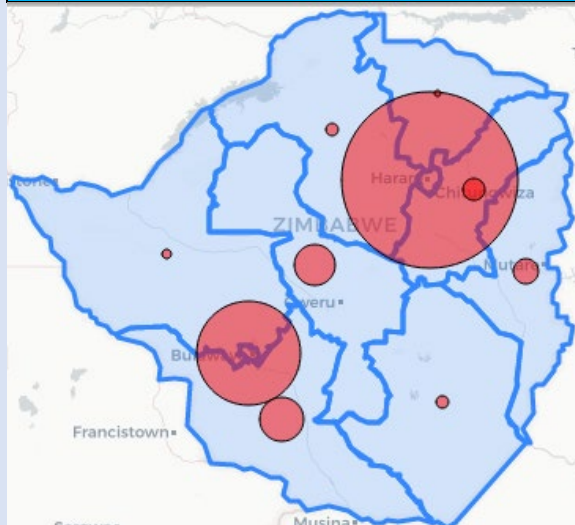


Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 22/08/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

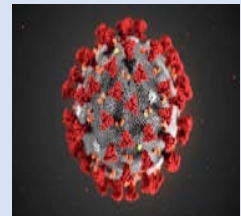
- **78** New Cases and **1** Death reported in the last 24 hours
- **All 78** are local cases
- **1** Death reported from Bulawayo Province
- Active Cases rise to **1111** today
- **42** total new recoveries reported (Bulawayo reported **22** recoveries today)
- As of 22 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded **5893** Cases **4629** recoveries and **153** Deaths.

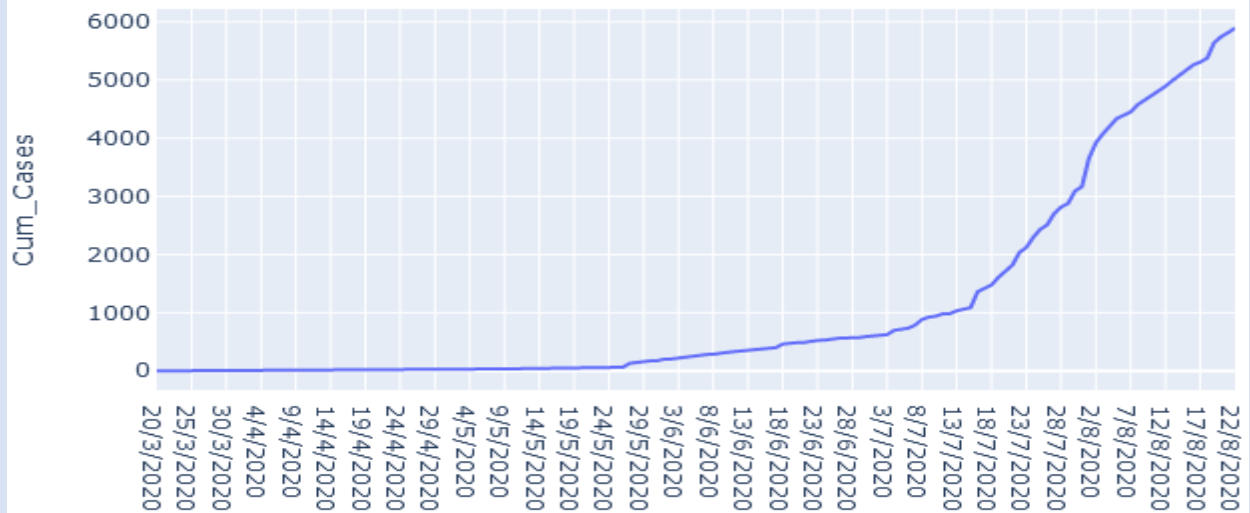

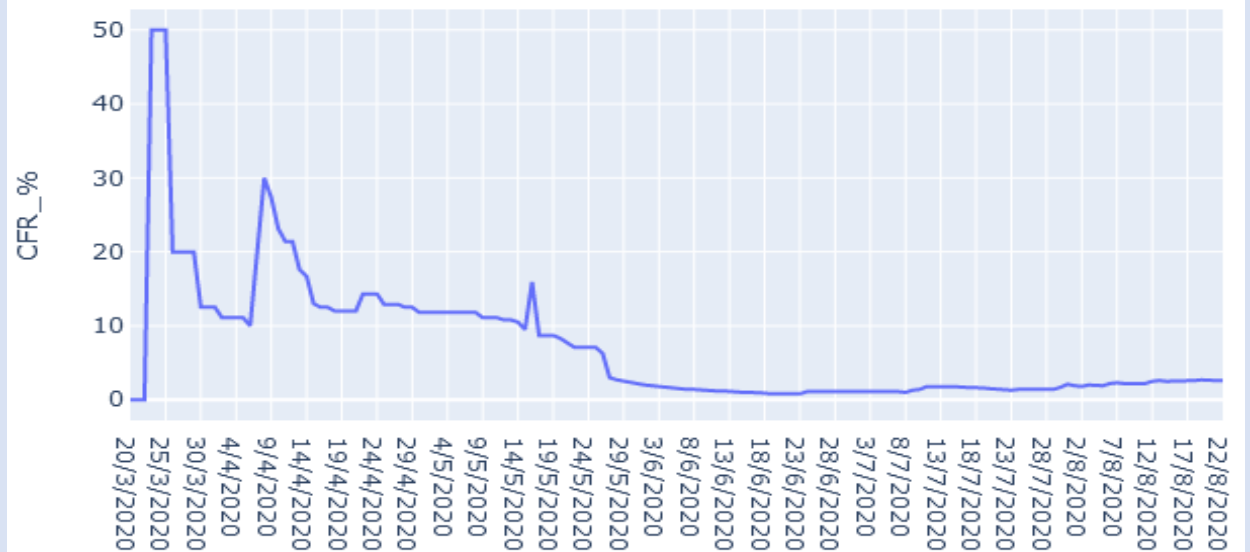

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases

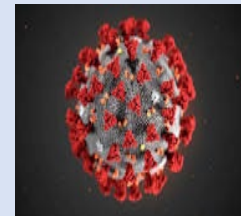


Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



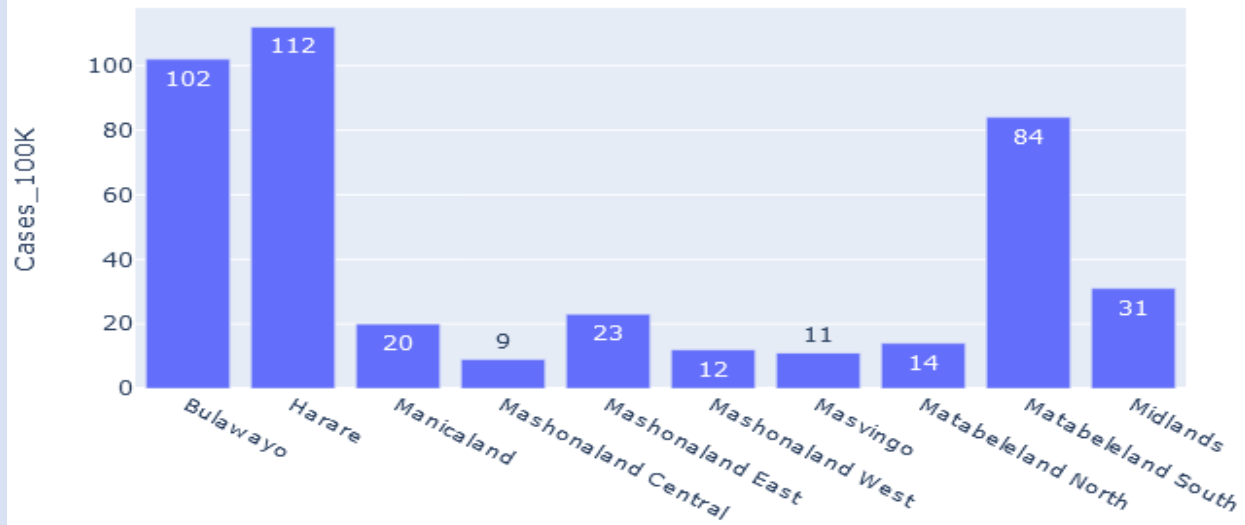
COMMENTS

- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at **2.6%** as at 22/8/20

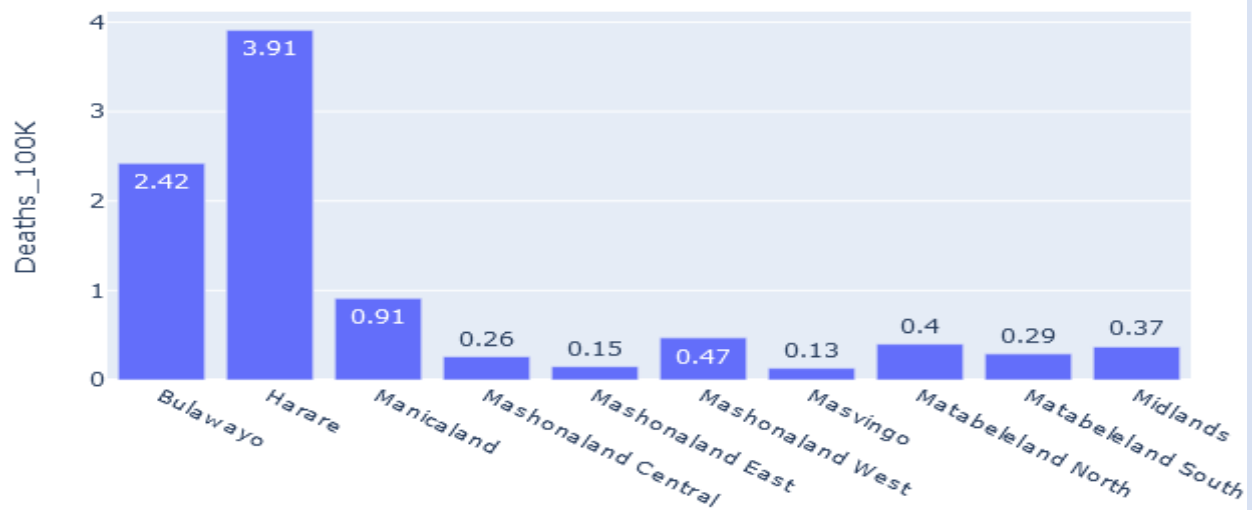

Zimbabwe Covid Cases Per 100K Popn

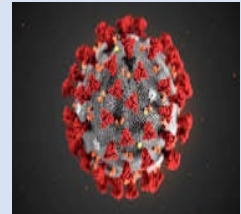


Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn



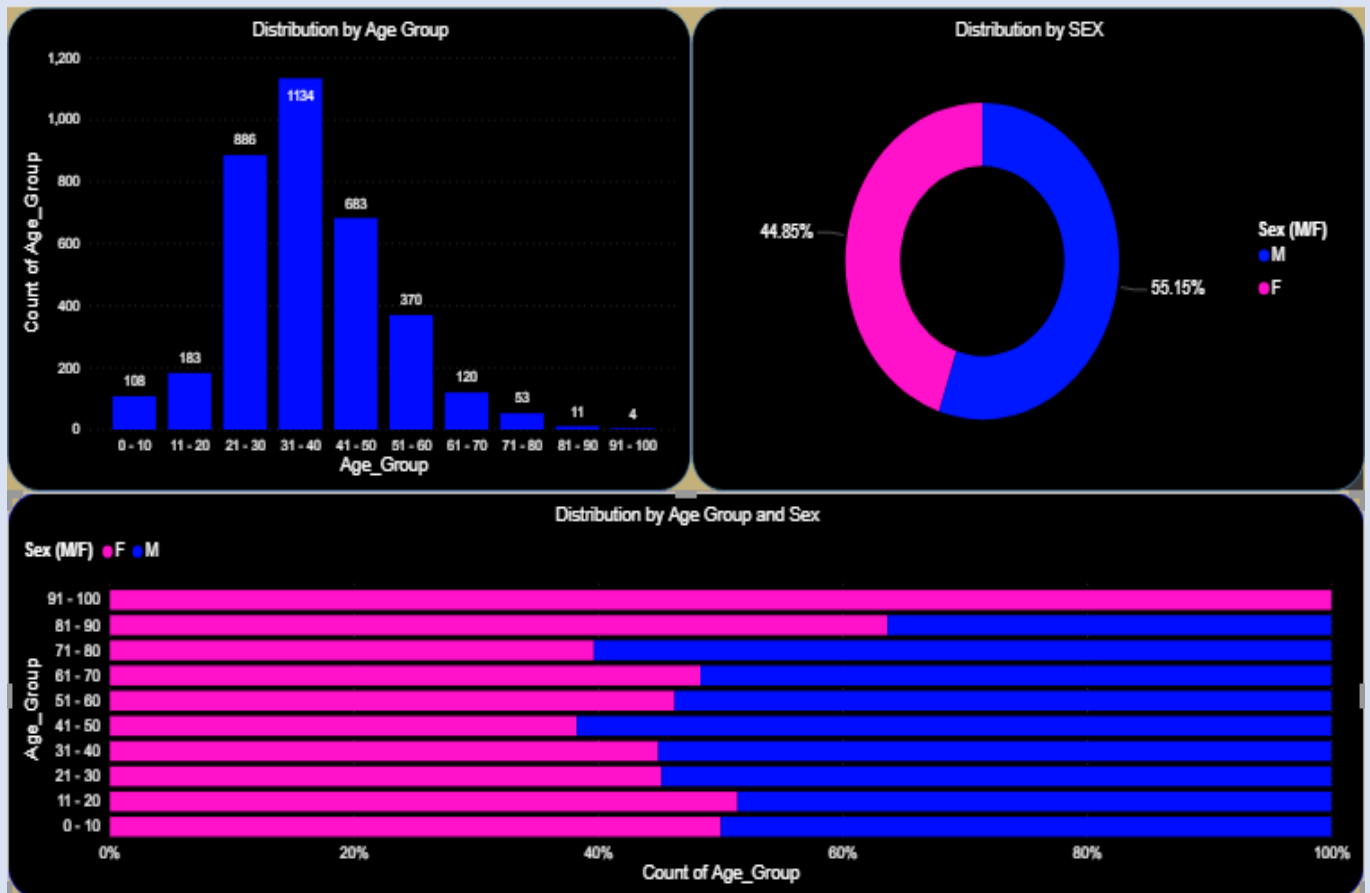
COMMENTS

- Harare has the highest number of deaths per capita followed by Bulawayo



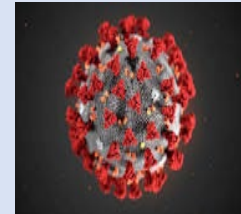
CHARACTERISTICS OF CASES

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



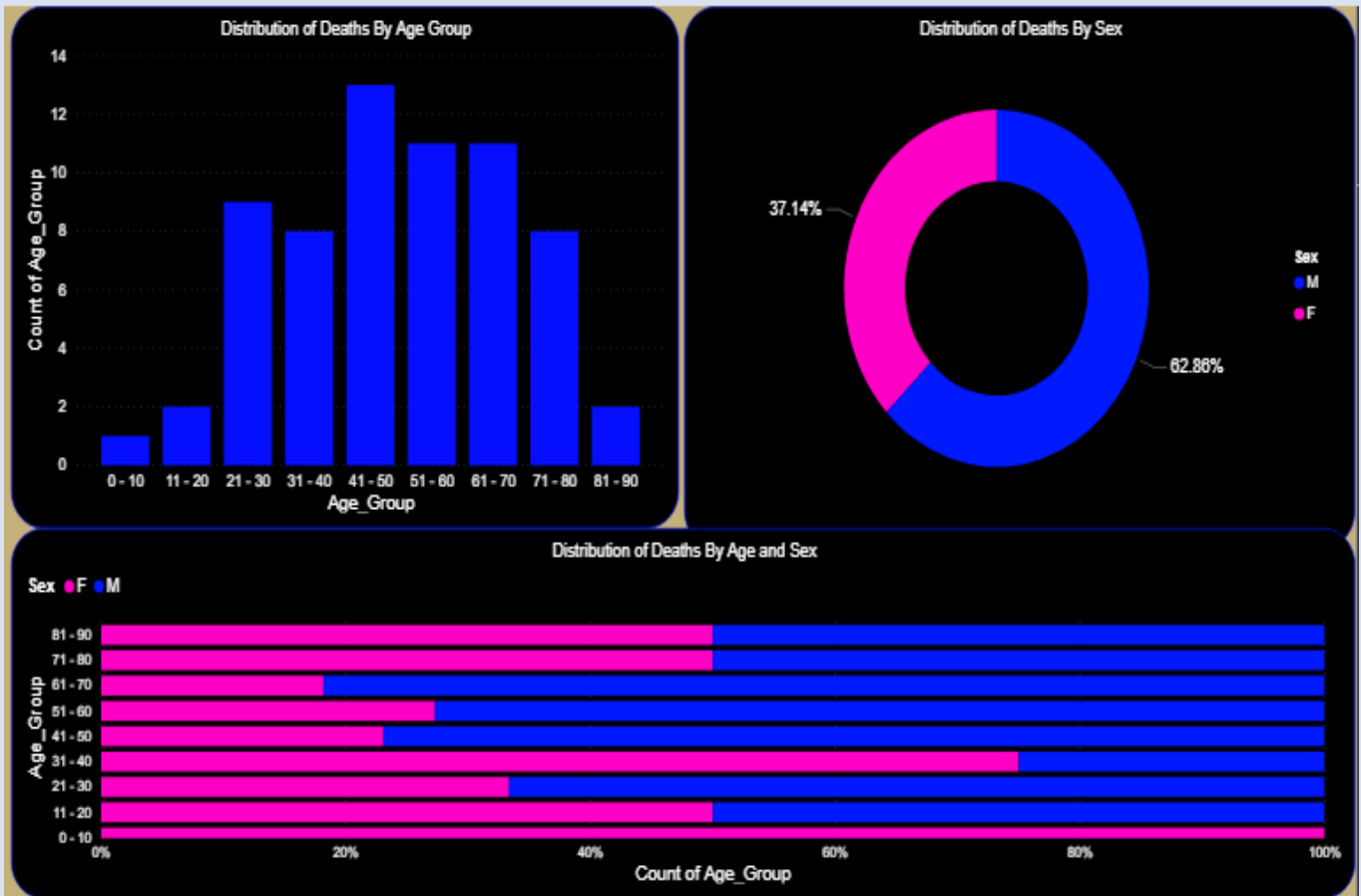
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths

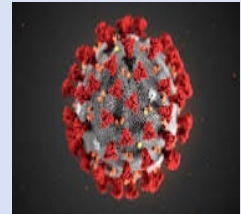

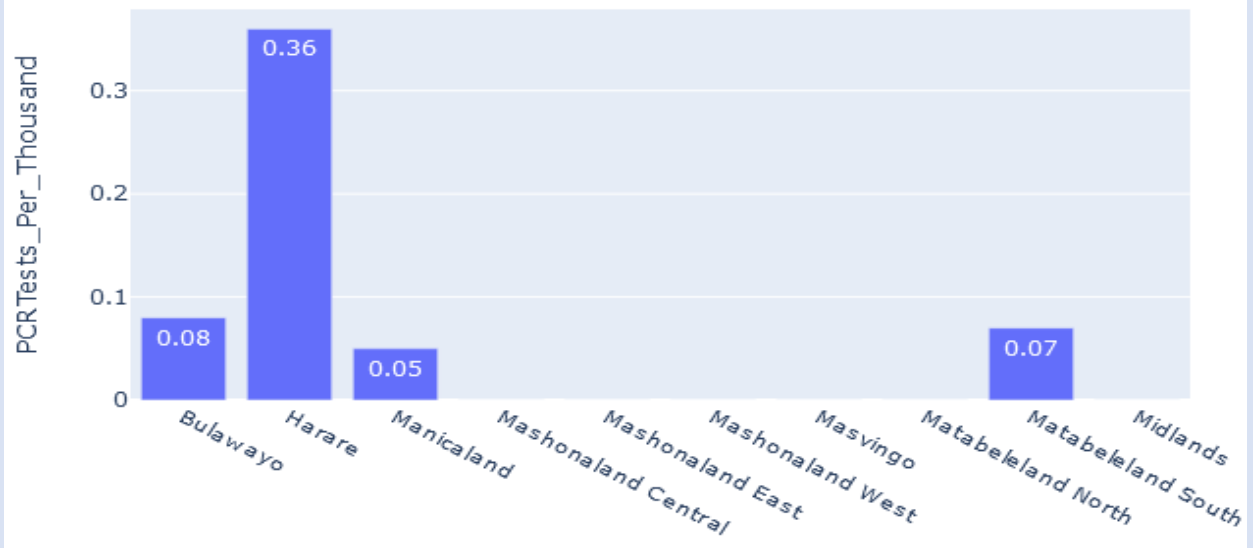
- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age

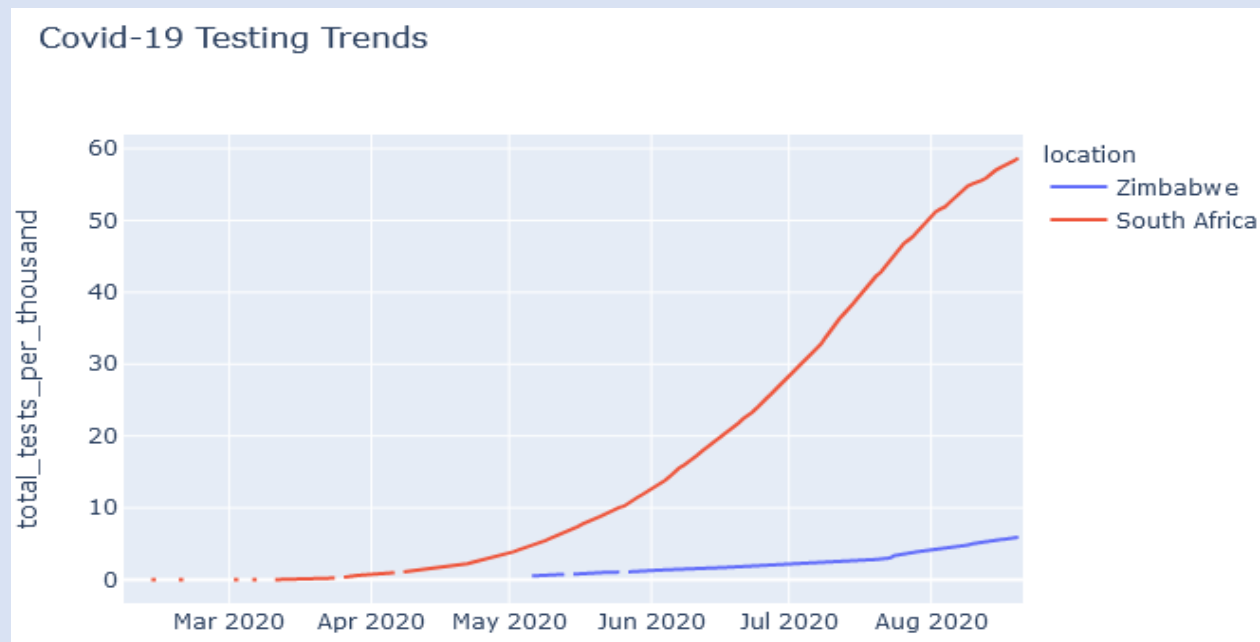

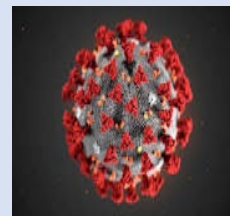


Number of PCR Tests done Per Thousand Population Today

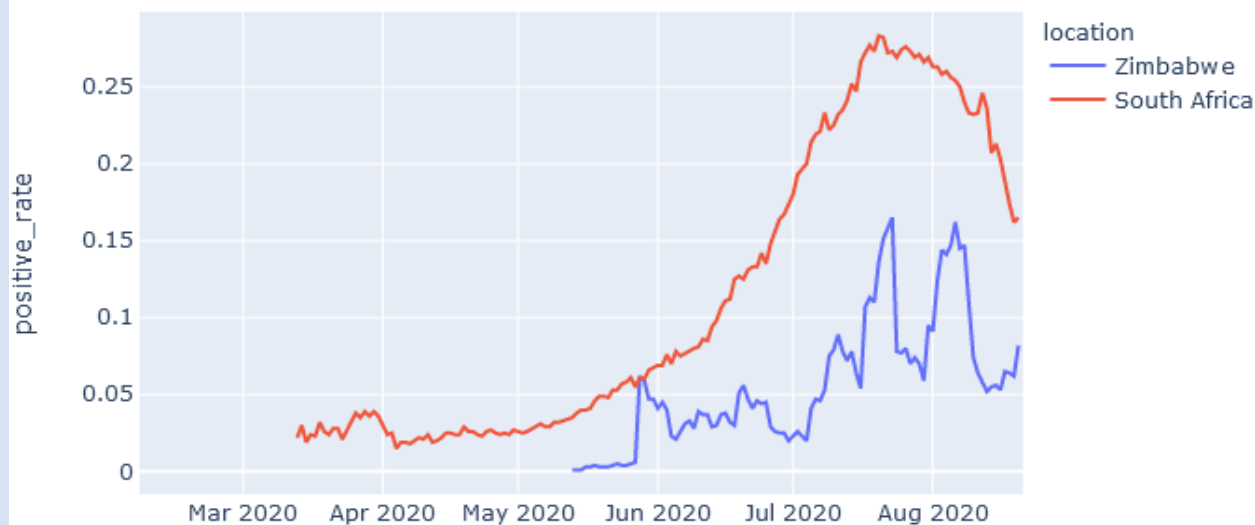

Covid-19 Positivity Zimbabwe and SA



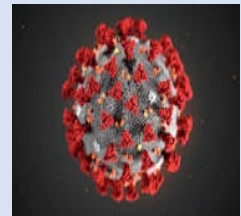
COMMENTS

- **Positivity has increased to 8.2%** (*targeted testing could account for this rise*)

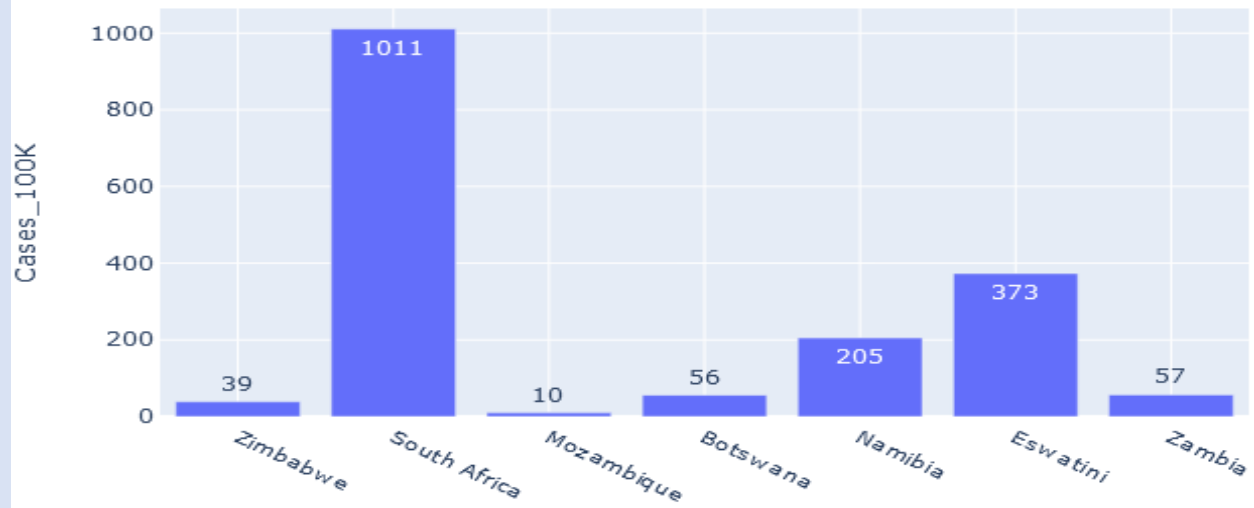

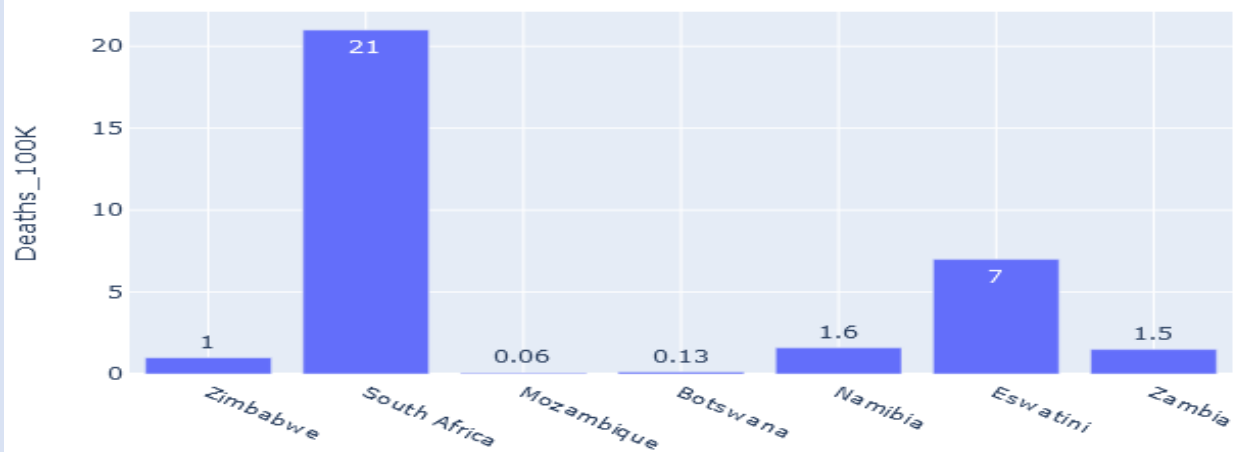
