





# Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 22/08/2020

# **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- 78 New Cases and 1 Death reported in the last 24 hours
- All 78 are local cases
- 1 Death reported from Bulawayo Province
- Active Cases rise to 1111 today
- 42 total new recoveries reported (Bulawayo reported 22 recoveries today)
- As of 22 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 5893 Cases 4629 recoveries and 153 Deaths.

















# Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate


- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend
- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at 2.6% as at 22/8/20





Zimbabwe Covid Cases Per 100K Popn




## Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn


- Harare now has the highest number of cases per capita followed by Bulawayo and Matabeleland South


## Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




### **COMMENTS**

# Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths




# **COMMENTS**

- There are more deaths from males as age rises




- Harare had the highest number of tests done per capita today












### SADC Covid Deaths Per 100K Population
