



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 22/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 5 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases further goes down to 19 from 25 yesterday).
- 637 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 0.8%)
- All 5 are local cases
- 31 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 78% and Active cases go down to 1506 today
- As of 22 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7711 Cases 5979 recoveries and 226 Deaths.









- Cumulative cases curve flattening

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises






