



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 23/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 14 New Cases and 1 Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases further goes down to 18 from 19 yesterday).
- 630 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 2.2%)
- All 14 are local cases (Death reported by Manicaland Province)
- 28 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 78% and Active cases go down to 1491 today
- As of 23 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7725 Cases 6007 recoveries and 227 Deaths.









- Cumulative cases curve flattening

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises






