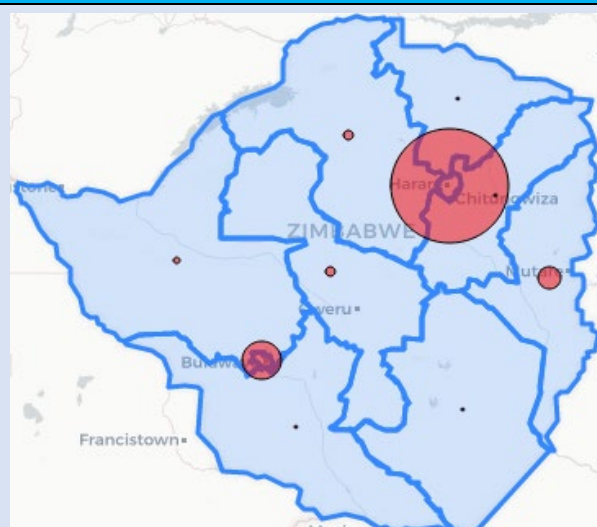
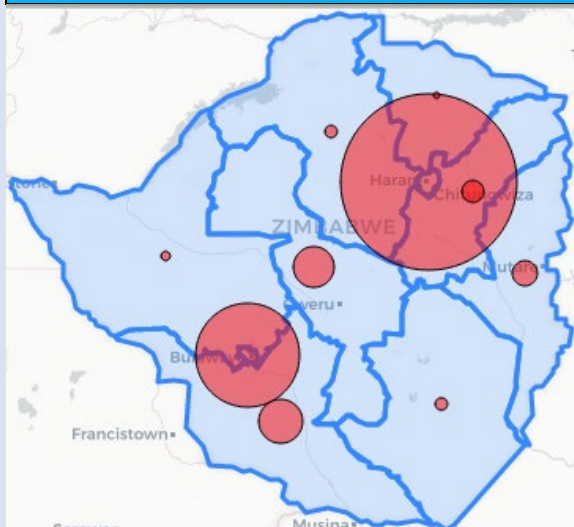


Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 24/08/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

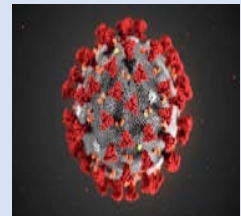
- **140** New Cases and **No** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours as cases surpass **6000**
- **134** are local cases and **5** are returnees from Botswana whilst **1** is from South Africa
- Active Cases go up to **965** today
- **78** total new recoveries reported (Midlands reported **33** recoveries today) National Recovery rate stands at **82%**
- As of 23 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded **6070** Cases **4950** recoveries and **155** Deaths.

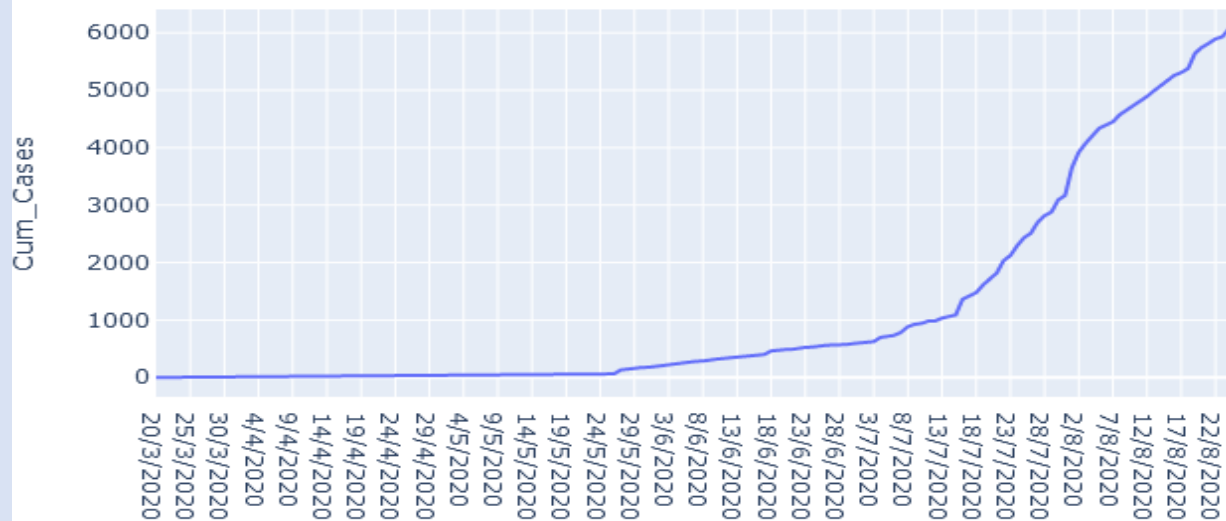

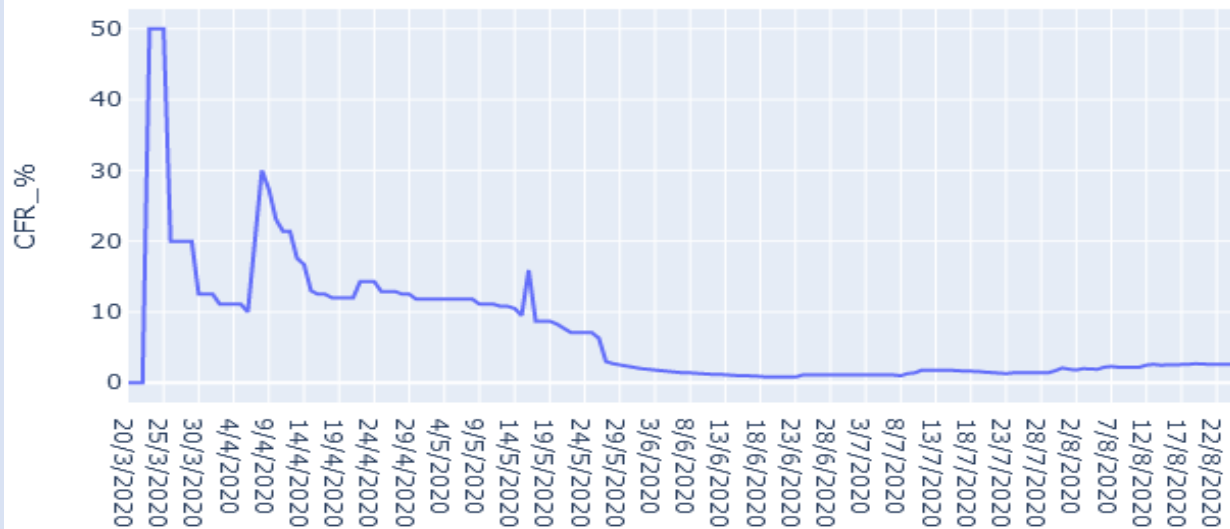

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases

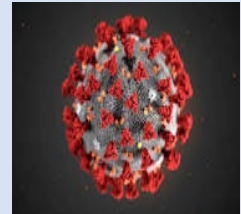


Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



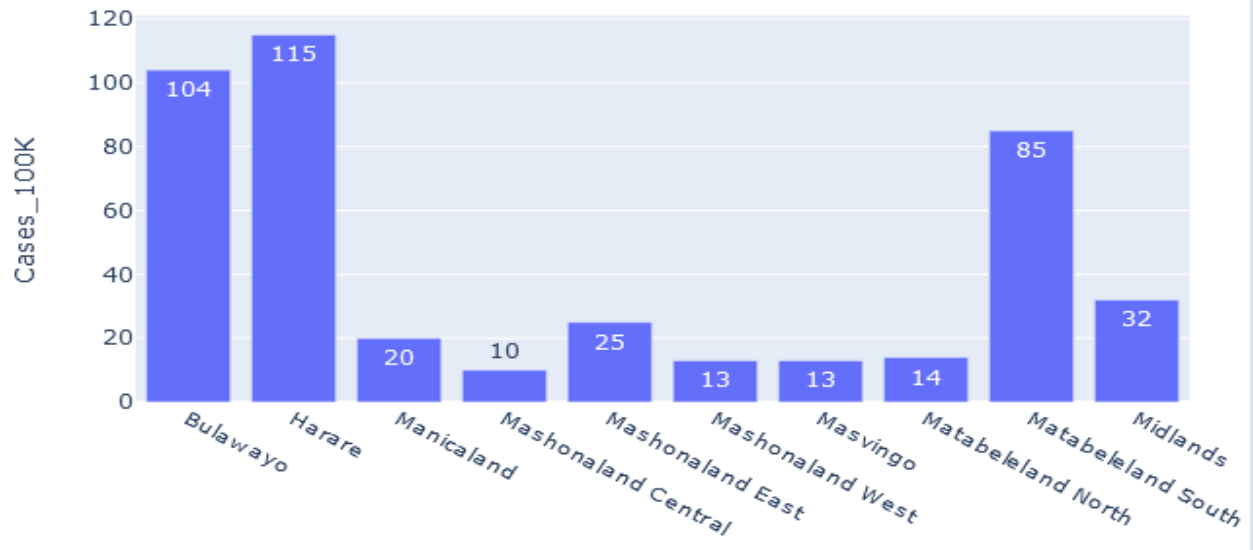
COMMENTS

- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at **2.6%** as at 24/8/20

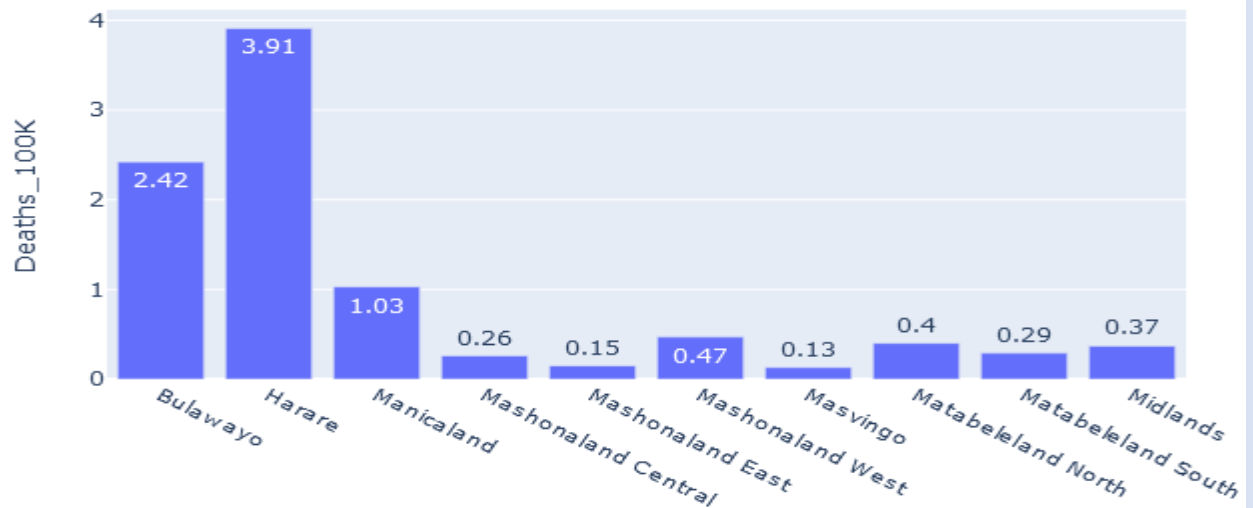

Zimbabwe Covid Cases Per 100K Popn

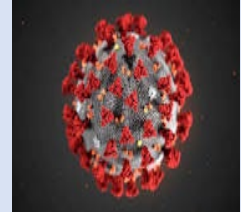


Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn



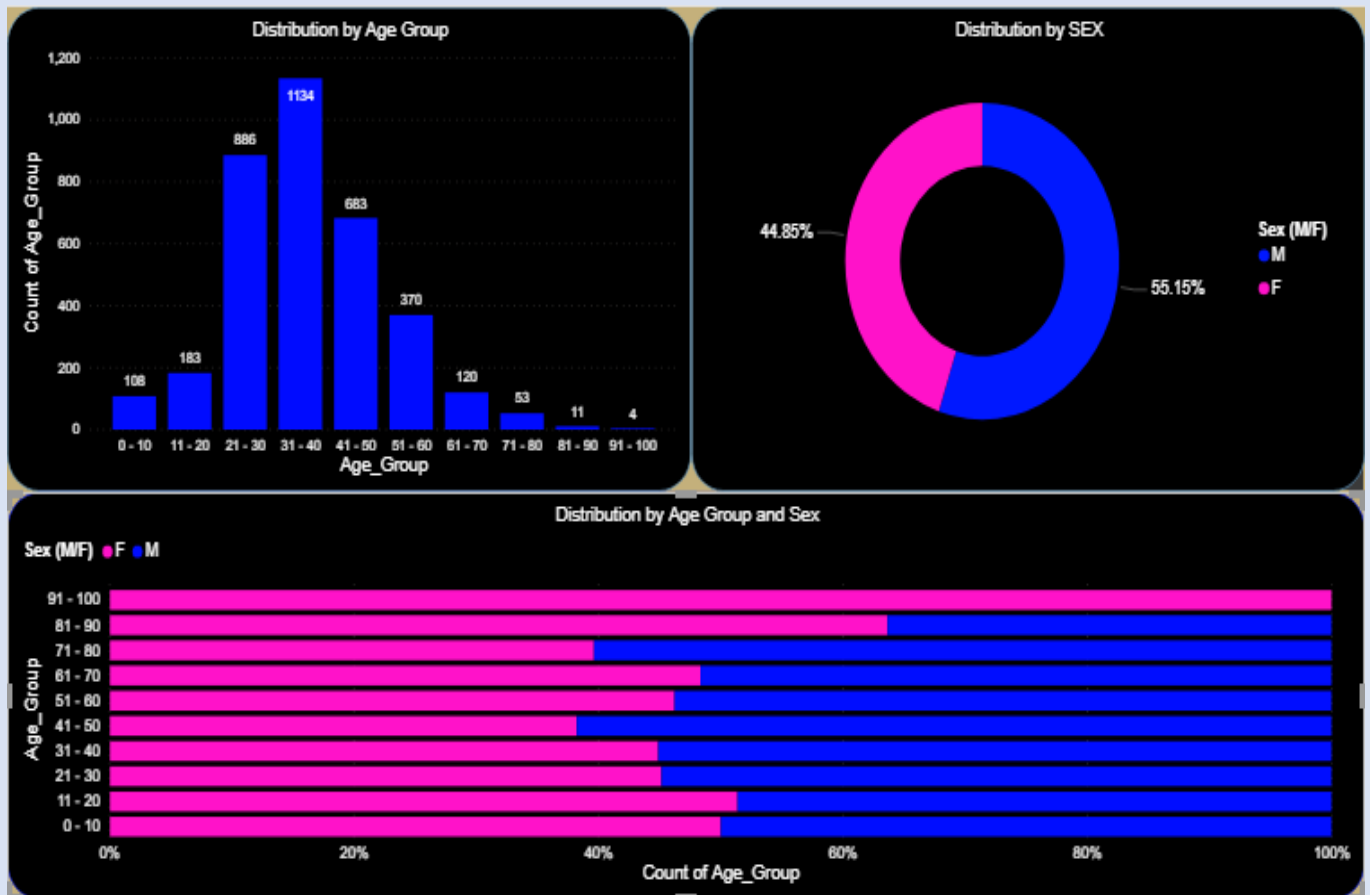
COMMENTS

- Harare has the highest number of deaths per capita followed by Bulawayo, Manicaland rising



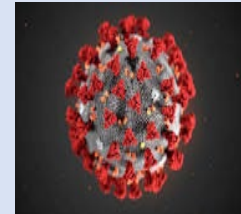
CHARACTERISTICS OF CASES

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



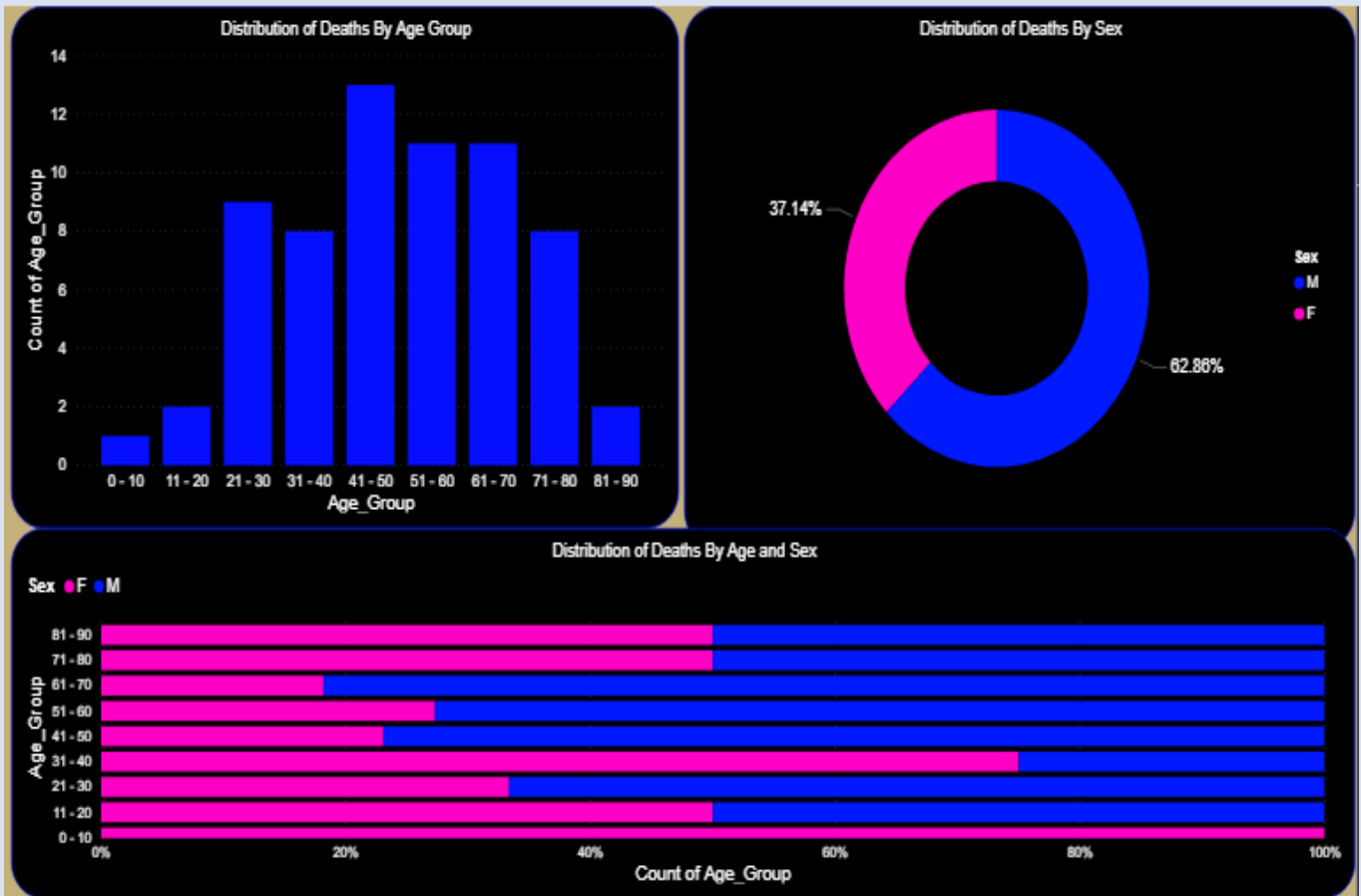
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths

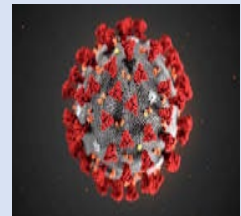

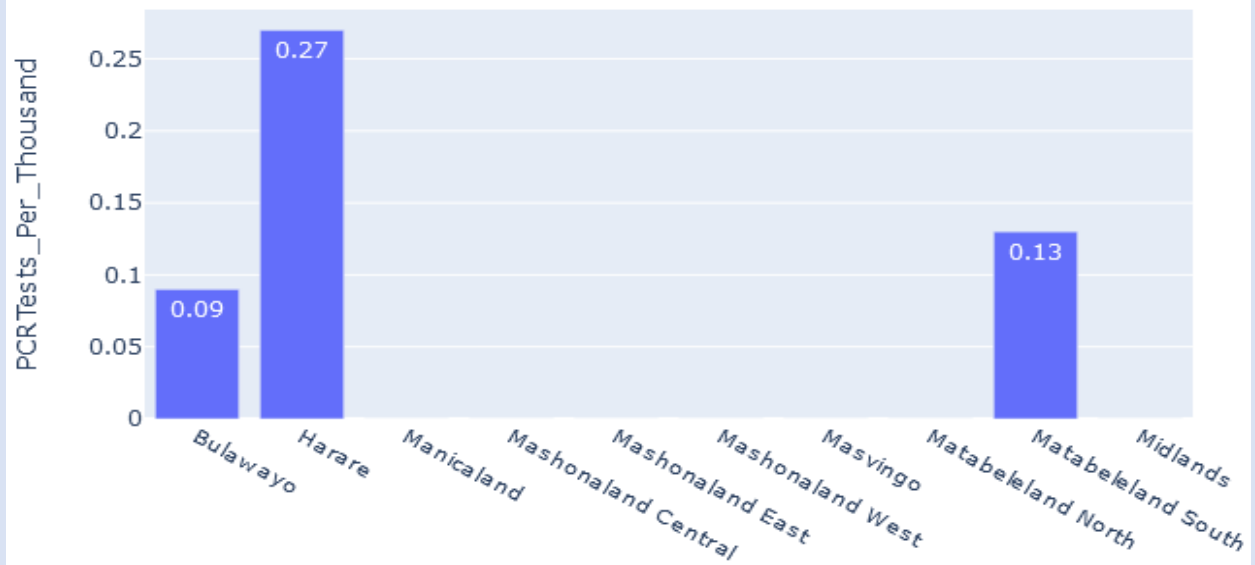
- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age

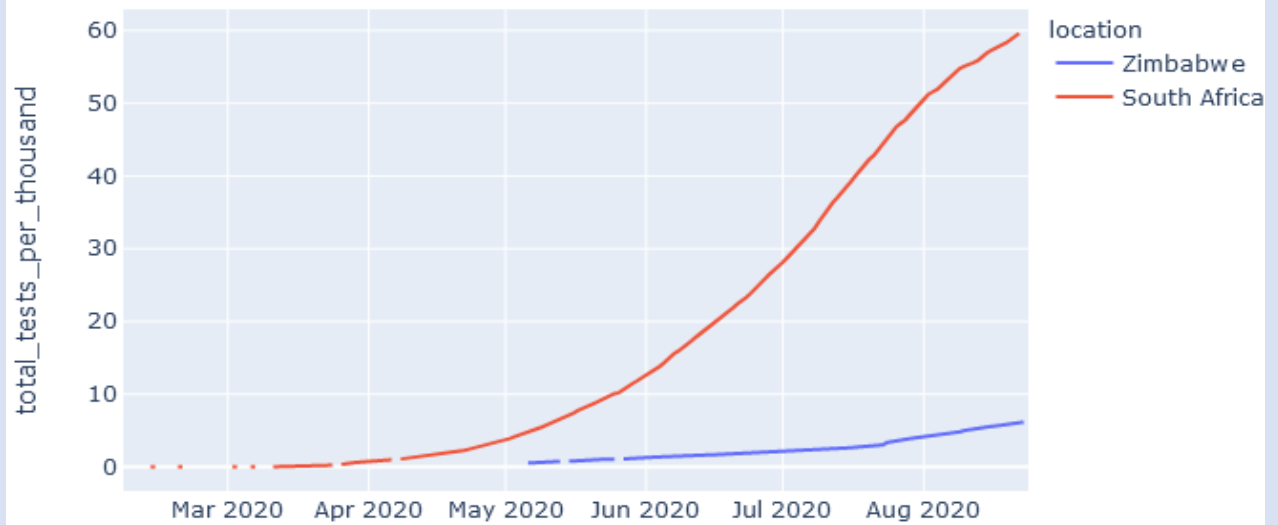


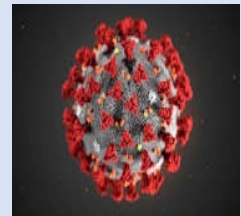
Number of PCR Tests done Per Thousand Population Today



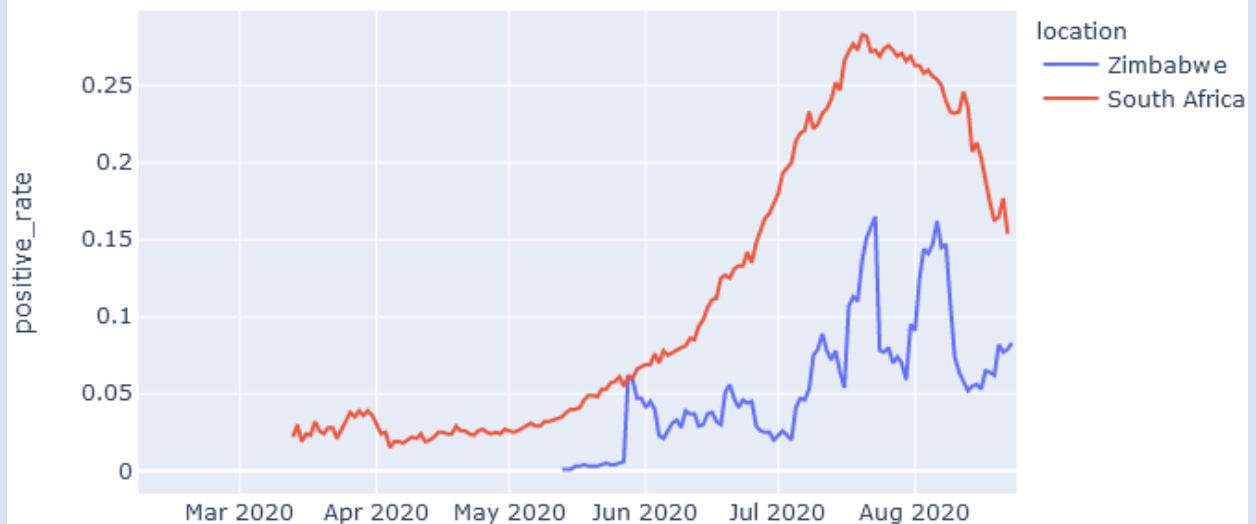

Covid-19 Positivity Zimbabwe and SA



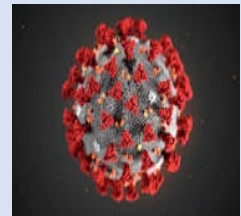
COMMENTS

- **Positivity has increased to 8.3%** (targeted testing could account for this rise)

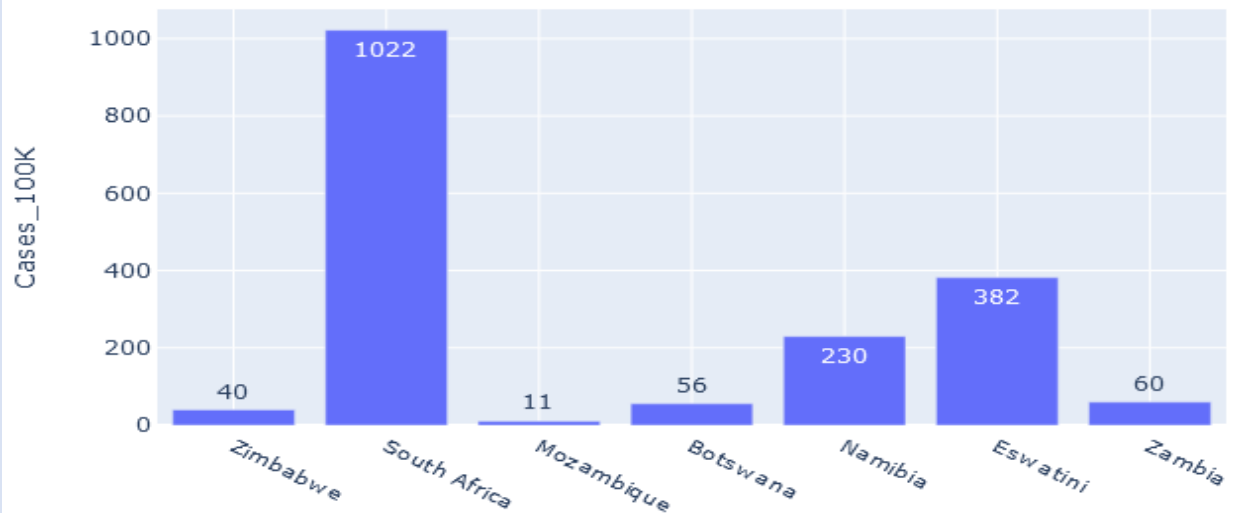

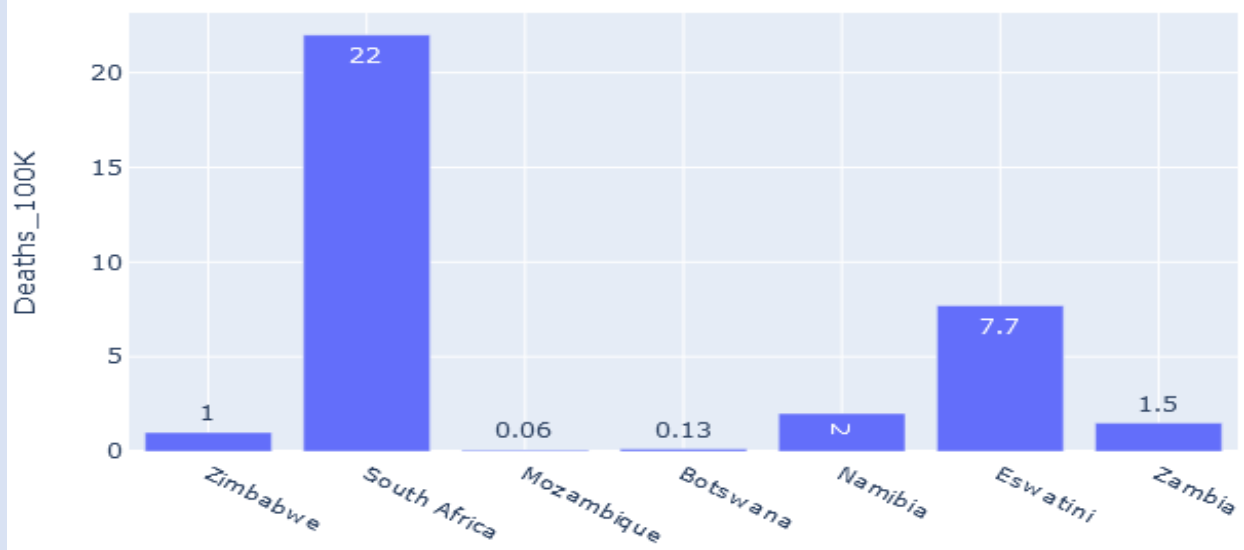
