



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 24/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 27 New Cases and No Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases further goes down to 17 from 18 yesterday).
- 721 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 3.7%)
- 26 are local cases and 1 is a returnee from Germany
- 36 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 78% and Active cases go down to 1482 today
- As of 24 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7752 Cases 6043 recoveries and 227 Deaths.









- Cumulative cases curve flattening

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises






