



# Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 25/08/2020

# **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- 126 New Cases and 11 Deaths reported in the last 24 hours
- 116 are local cases and 8 are returnees from Botswana while 2 are from SA
- Active Cases go up to 1069 today
- **10** Deaths are from Harare Province and **1** from Mash West
- 11 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 80%
- As of 25 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 6196 Cases 4961 recoveries and 166 Deaths.







#### Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases




### Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate


- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend
- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at 2.7% as at 25/8/20





#### Zimbabwe Covid Cases Per 100K Popn




# Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn




#### COMMENTS

- Harare has the highest number of deaths per capita followed by Bulawayo, Manicaland rising




#### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases


- More males affected when compared to females

#### Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths




## **COMMENTS**

- There are more deaths from males as age rises









## Number of PCR Tests done Per Thousand Population Today





• Harare had the highest number of tests done per capita today


• The trends show that when compared to South Africa Zimbabwe has been testing much less per capita but testing rates in Zimbabwe are increasing

• **Positivity has increased to 8.3%** (targeted testing could account for this rise)




