



## Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 25/09/2020

### **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- **35** New Cases and **No** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases further goes up to 20 from 17 yesterday).
- 667 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 5.2%)
- 16 are local cases and 18 are returnees from SA and 1 is from Botswana
- 14 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 78% and Active cases go up to 1503 today
- As of 25 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7787 Cases 6057 recoveries and 227 Deaths.



#### Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate





- National Case fatality Rate now stands at 2.9 % as at 25/9/20



### Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




#### COMMENTS

#### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




#### COMMENTS

# COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)




