





Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 26/08/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 55 New Cases and 13 Deaths reported in the last 24 hours (No new cases reported in Harare and Byo but Harare reports 10 deaths to go past 100 deaths in Harare alone)
- 36 are local cases and 5 are returnees from Botswana while 14 are from SA
- Active Cases go up to 1071 today
- The other Deaths are from Mash East (1) and Mat South(2)
- 40 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 80%
- As of 26 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 6251 Cases 5001 recoveries and 179 Deaths.

















Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate


- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend
- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at 2.9% as at 26/8/20





Zimbabwe Covid Cases Per 100K Popn




Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn


- Harare now has the highest number of cases per capita followed by Bulawayo and Matabeleland South


Age and Sex Distribution for Cases


- More males affected when compared to females

Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths




COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises




- Harare had the highest number of tests done per capita today




