





Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 27/08/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 41 New Cases and 10 Deaths reported in the last 24 hours (No new cases reported in Harare again -second successive day without new cases in Harare)
- 38 are local cases and 3 are returnees from SA
- Active Cases go up to 1093 today
- 7 Deaths are from Harare, 1 from Bulawayo, Mash Cent (1) and Midlands(1)
- 9 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 79.6%
- As of 27 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 6292 Cases 5010 recoveries and 189 Deaths.








Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases


- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend
- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at 3 % as at 27/8/20






Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn


- Harare now has the highest number of cases per capita followed by Bulawayo and Matabeleland South


Age and Sex Distribution for Cases


- More males affected when compared to females

Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths




COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises




- Harare had the highest number of tests done per capita today




