



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 27/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 9 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases goes down to 18 from 19 yesterday).
- 238 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 3.8%)
- All 9 are local cases
- 39 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 78% and Active cases go down to 1479 today
- As of 27 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7812 Cases 6106 recoveries and 227 Deaths.





- National Case fatality Rate now stands at 2.9 % as at 27/9/20



Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- More males affected when compared to females


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)






