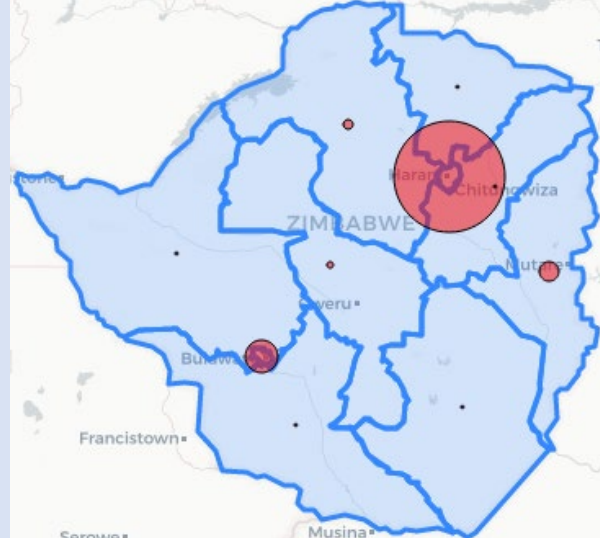
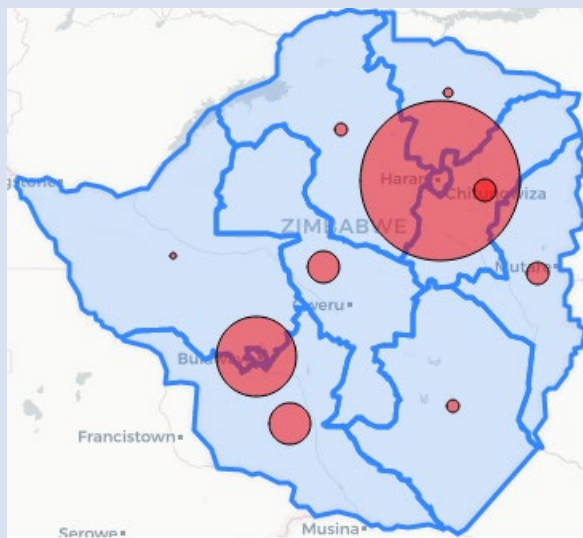


## Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 28/08/2020

### HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

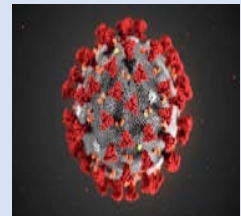
- **96** New Cases and **6** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours
- **76** are local cases and **20** are returnees from SA
- Active Cases go up to **1150** today
- **4** Deaths are from Mash West, **1** from Bulawayo, and Manicaland (**1**). (*Mash West CFR rises to 5%*)
- **33** total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **78.9%**
- As of 28 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded **6388** Cases **5043** recoveries and **195** Deaths.

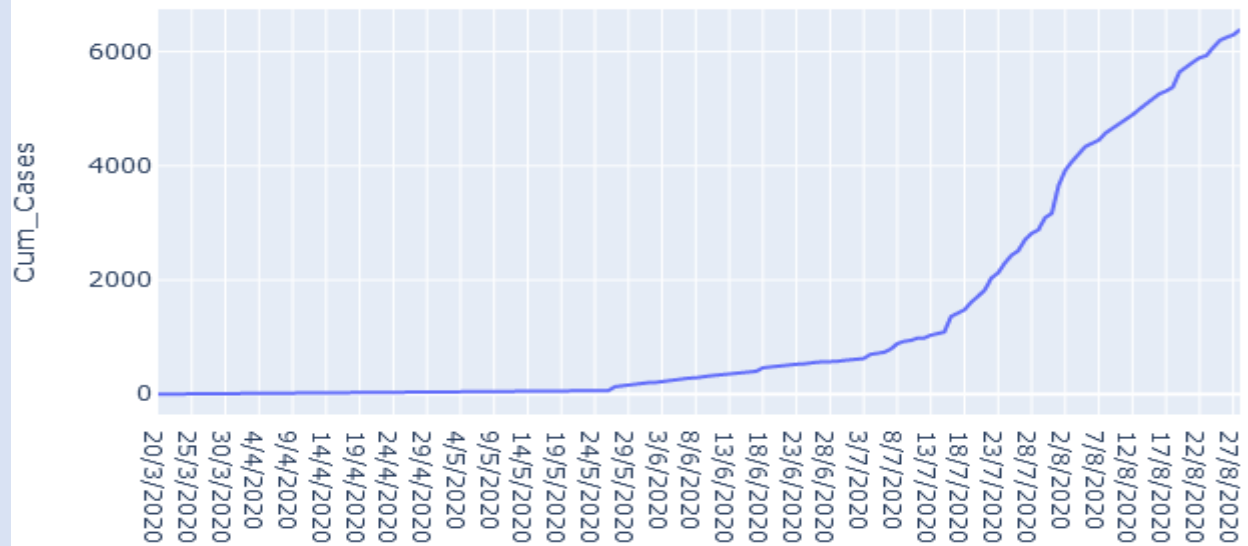

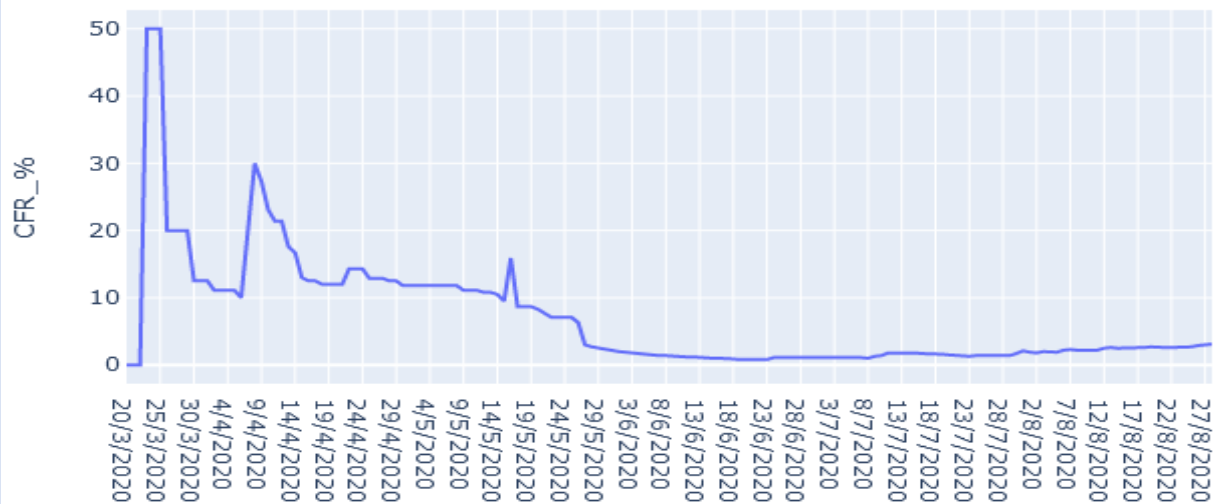

## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases

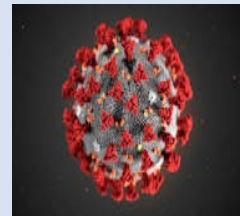


## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



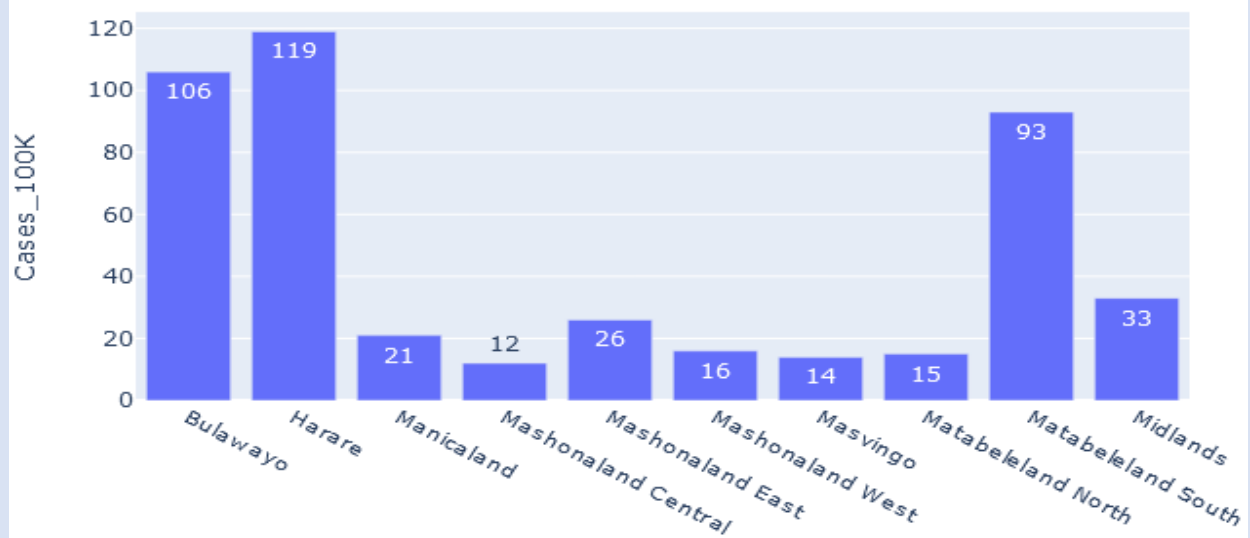
### COMMENTS

### Zimbabwe Covid Cases Per 100K Popn

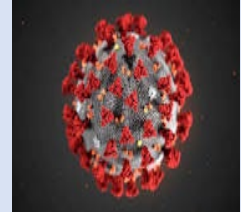


### Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn



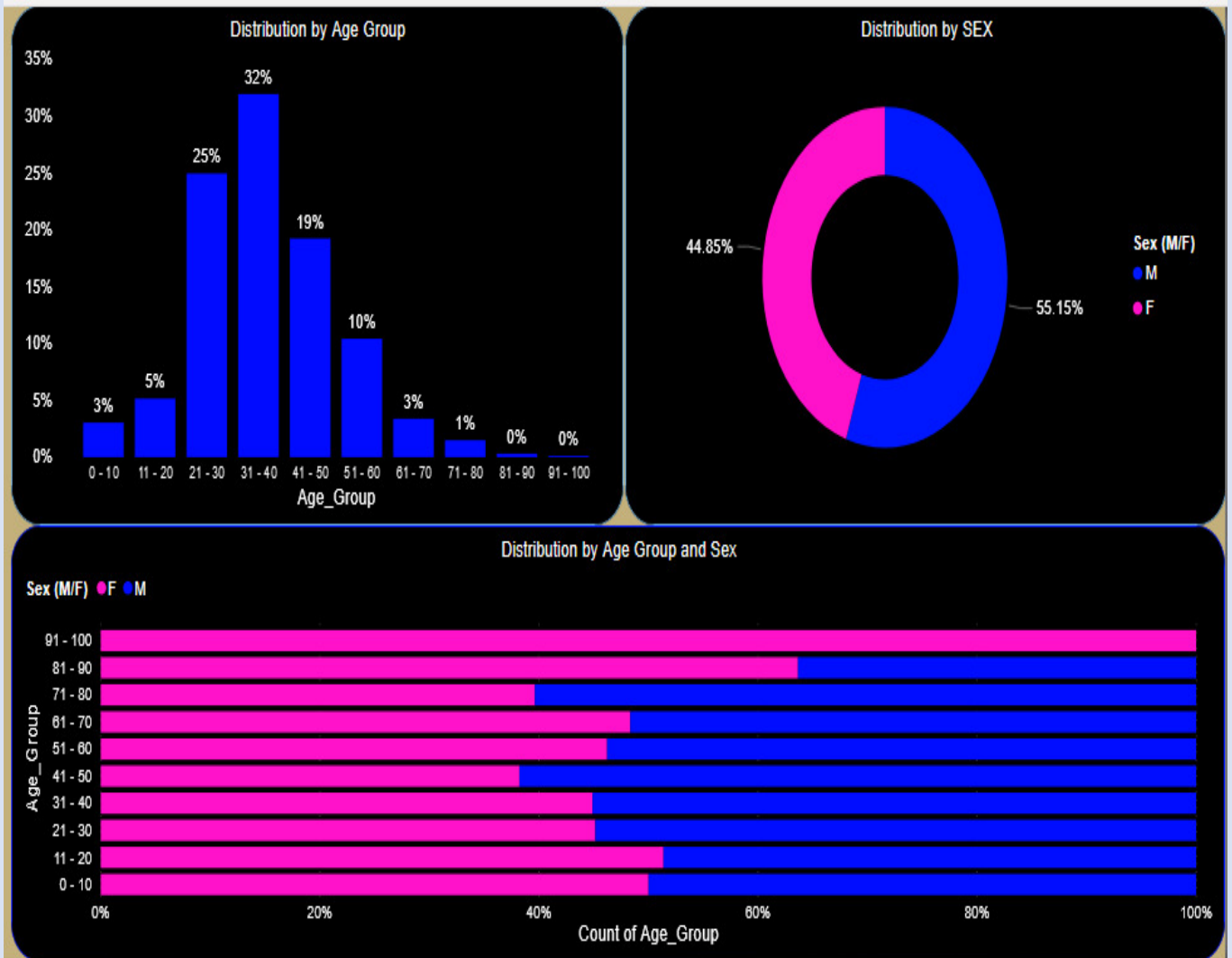
## COMMENTS

- Harare has the highest number of deaths per capita followed by Bulawayo, Manicaland rising



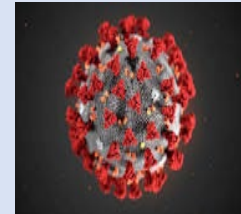

### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



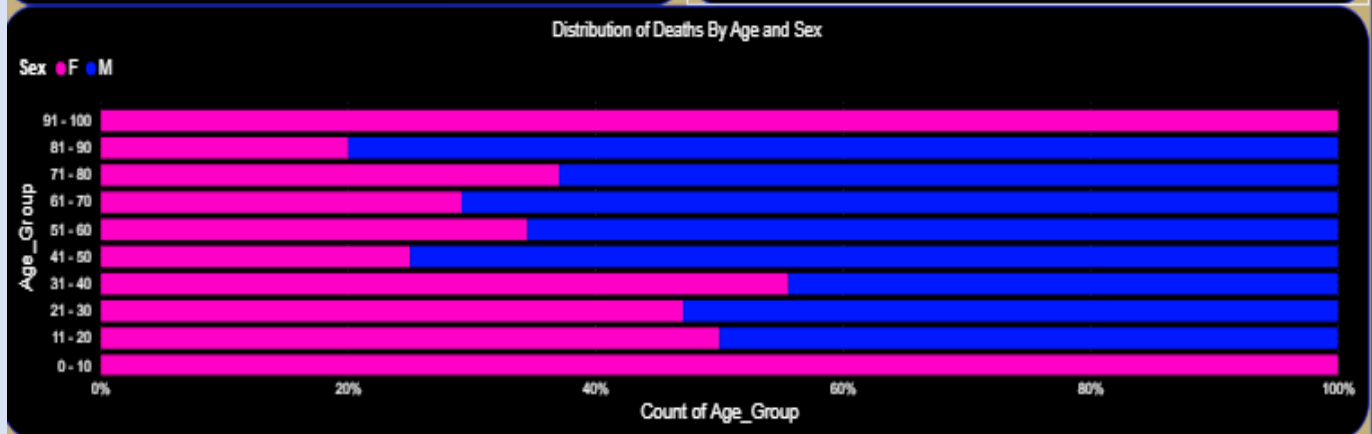
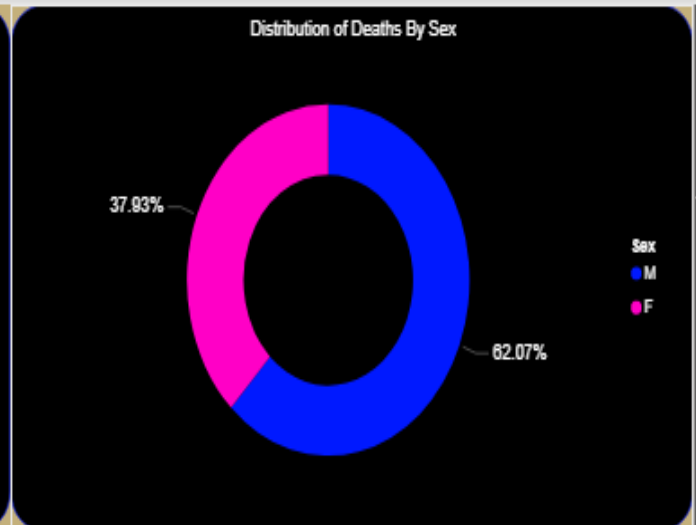
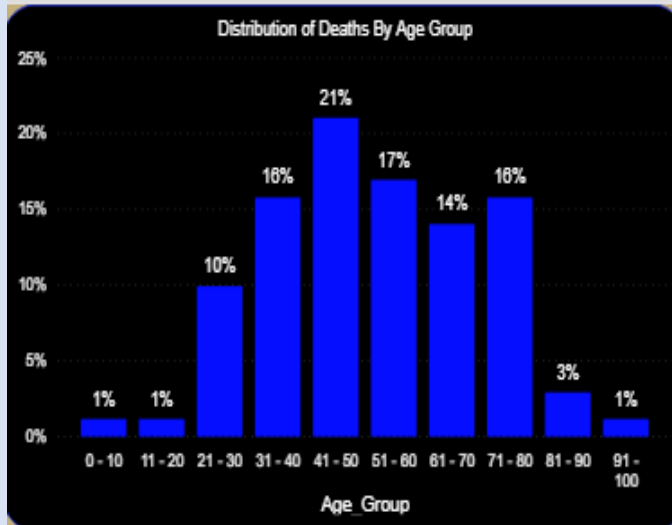
### COMMENTS

### Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths

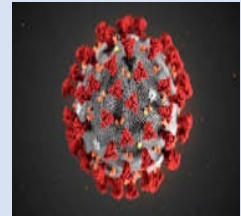

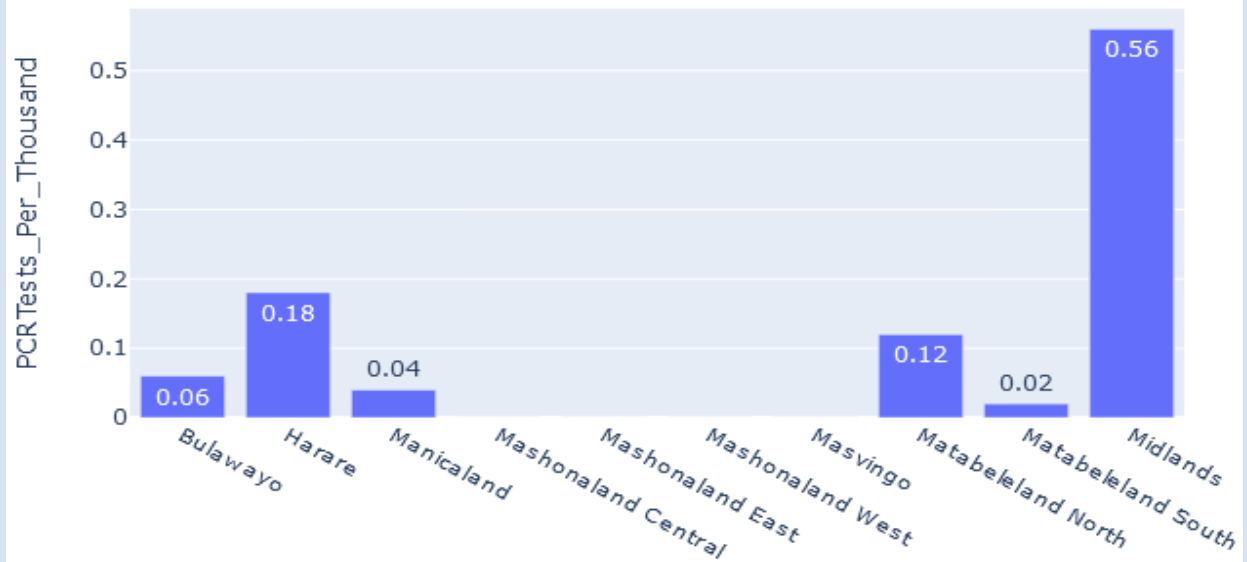
- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age (68%)

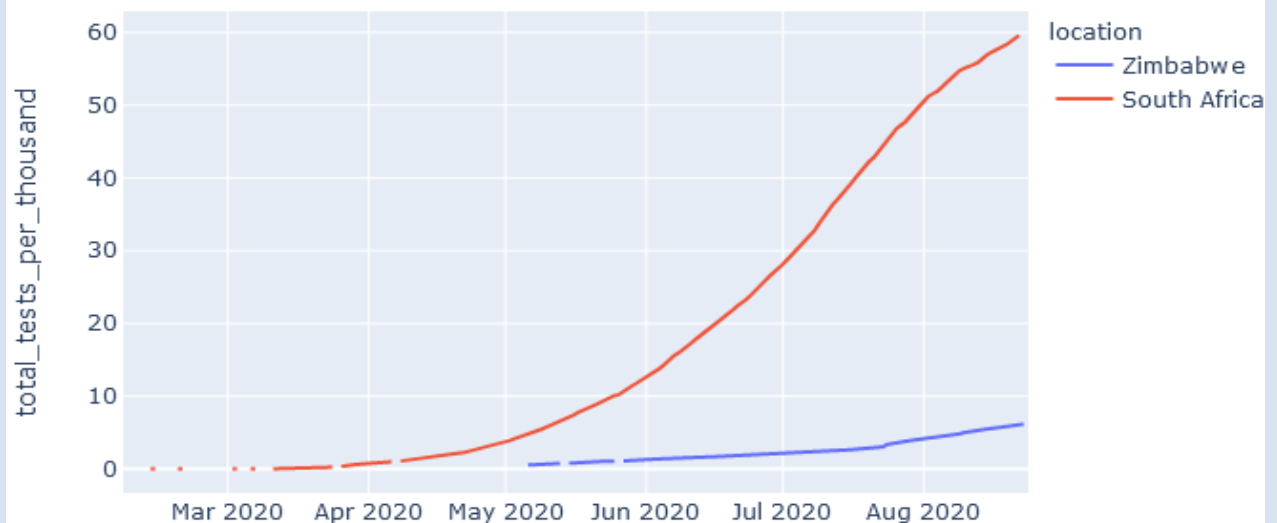


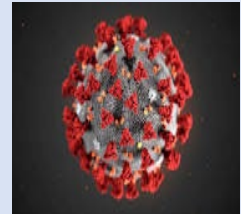
Number of PCR Tests done Per Thousand Population Today



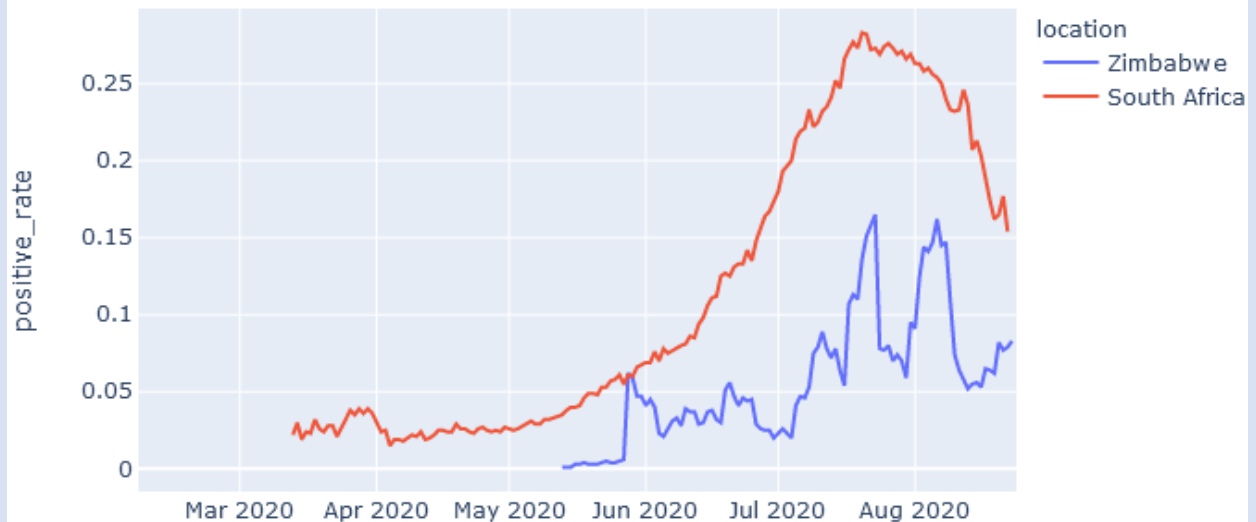

## Covid-19 Positivity Zimbabwe and SA



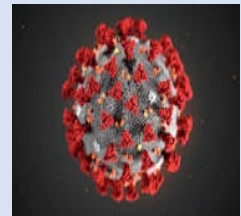
### COMMENTS

- **Positivity has increased to 8.3%** (targeted testing could account for this rise)

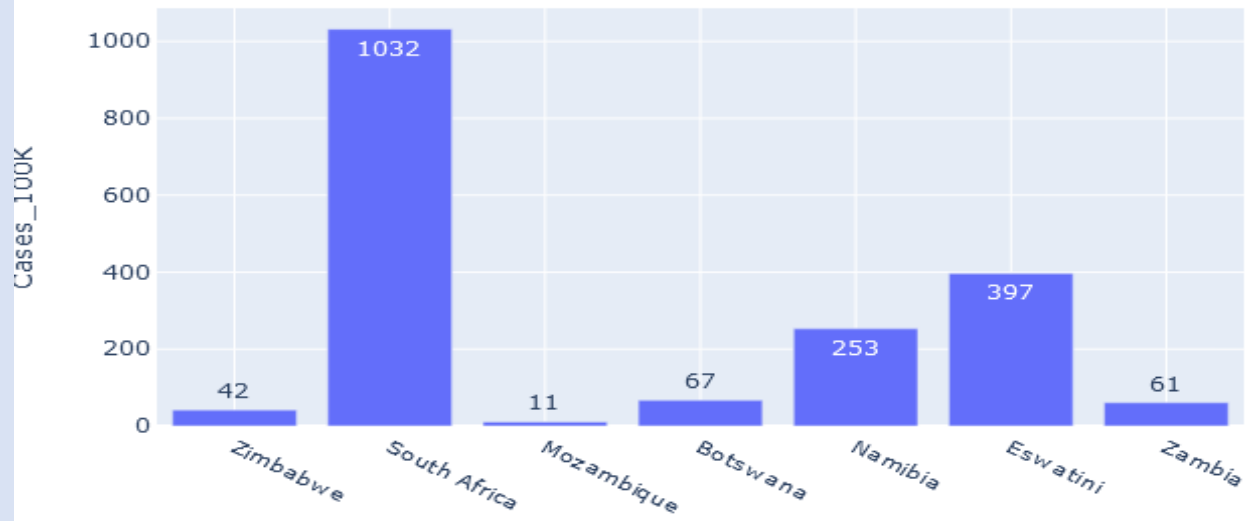

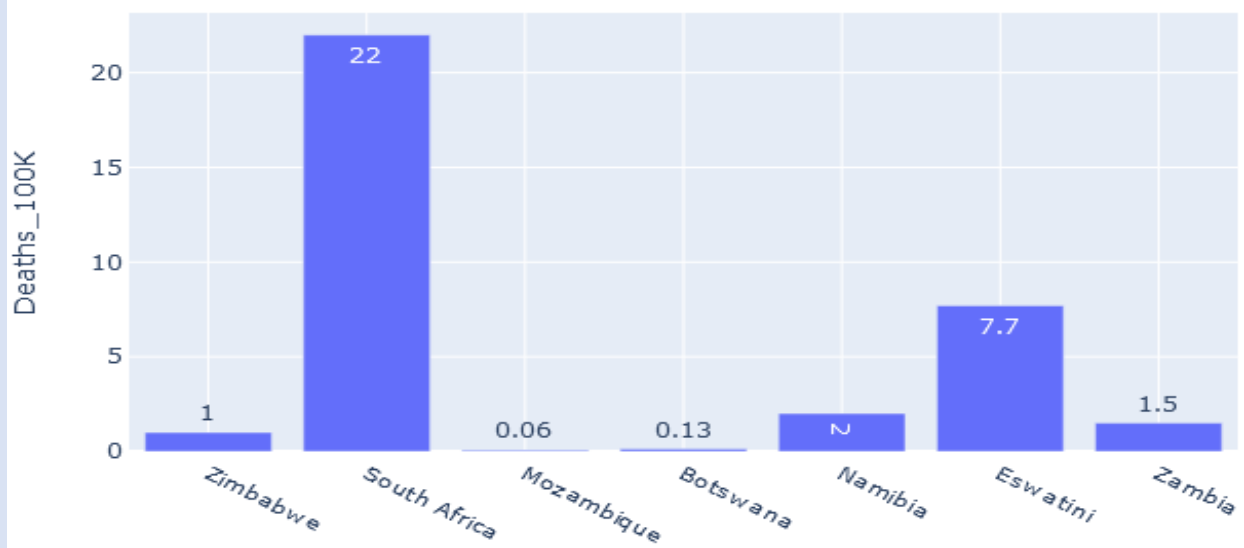
