



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 28/11/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 108 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases rises to 93 from 85 yesterday).
- 1721 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 6.3%)
- All 108 are local cases
- 2 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 86.3% and Active cases go up to 1075 today
- As of 28 November 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 9822 Cases 8472 recoveries and 275 Deaths.

CASES AND DEATHS DISTRIBUTION





Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate




- Cumulative cases curve spiking

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises






