



# Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 28/09/2020

### **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- 4 New Cases and 1 Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases goes down to 16 from 18 yesterday).
- 504 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 0.8%)
- All 4 are local cases (Death reported by Bulawayo Province)
- 6 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 78% and Active cases go down to 1476 today
- As of 28 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7816 Cases 6112 recoveries and 228 Deaths.






- Cumulative cases curve flattening
- National Case fatality Rate now stands at 2.9 % as at 28/9/20




#### COMMENTS

#### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases






- More males affected when compared to females


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)




