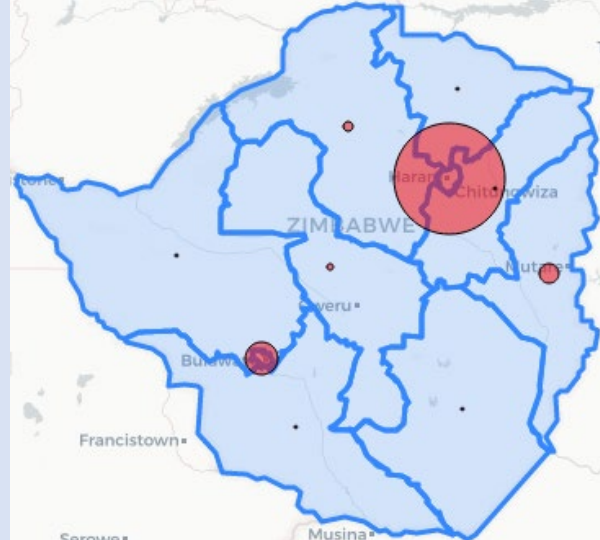
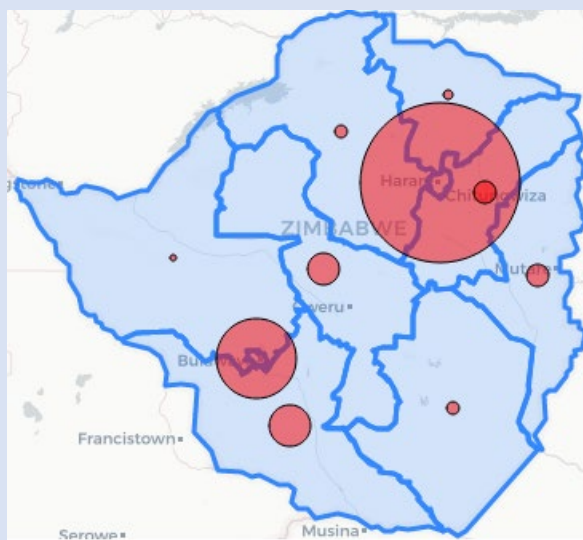

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

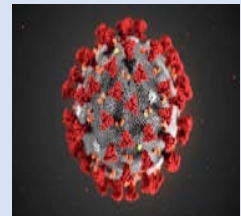
- **18** New Cases and **1** Death reported in the last 24 hours
- All **18** are local cases. *No new cases reported from Harare Province Today*
- Active Cases go up to **1154** today
- **1** Death reported from Bulawayo.
- **13** total new recoveries reported: All from Manicaland: National Recovery rate stands at **78.9%**
- As of 29 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded **6406** Cases **5056** recoveries and **196** Deaths.

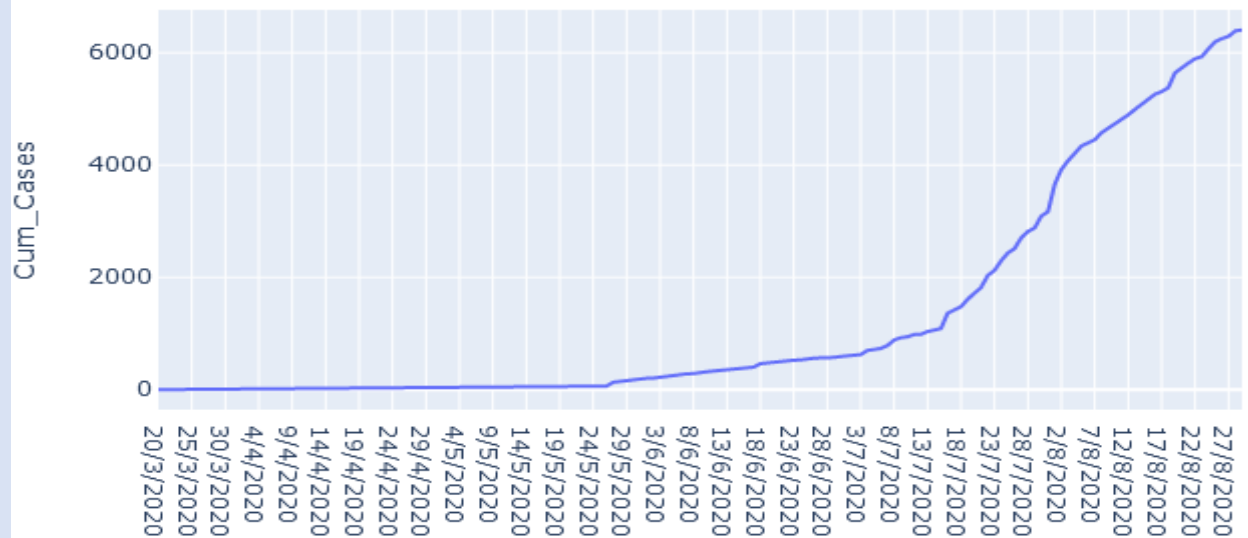

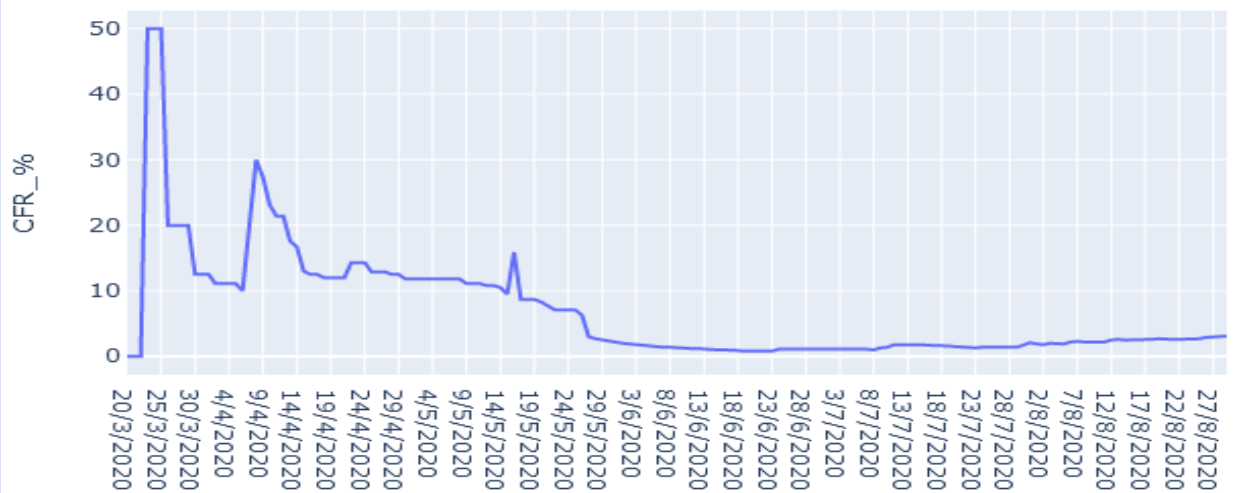

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases

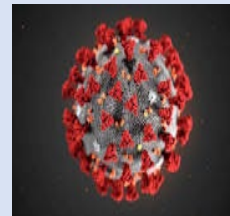


Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



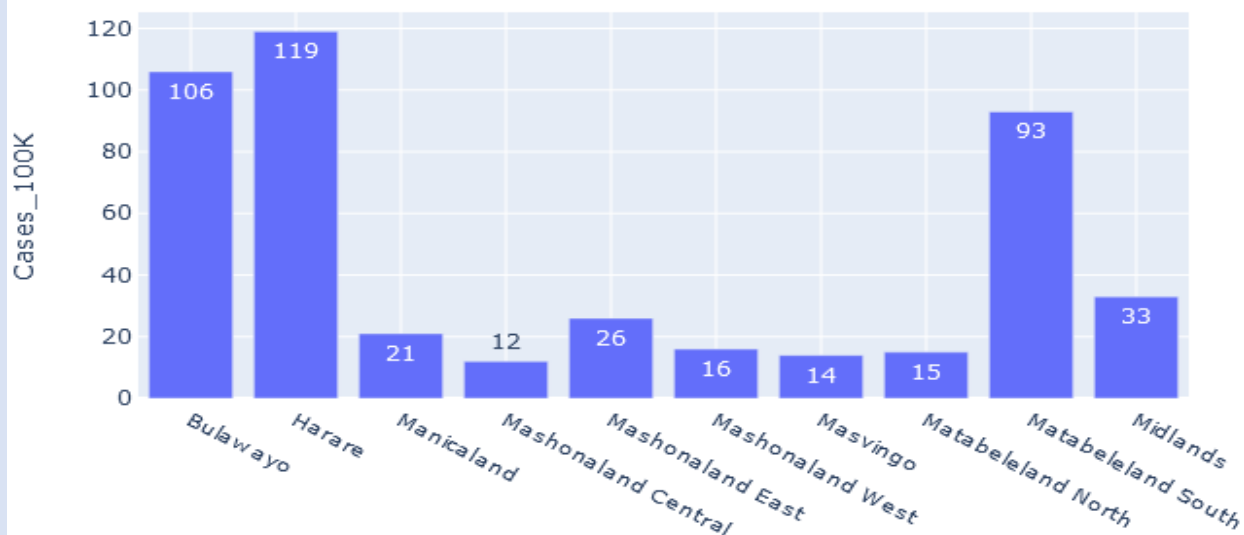
COMMENTS

- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at **3.1 %** as at 29/8/20

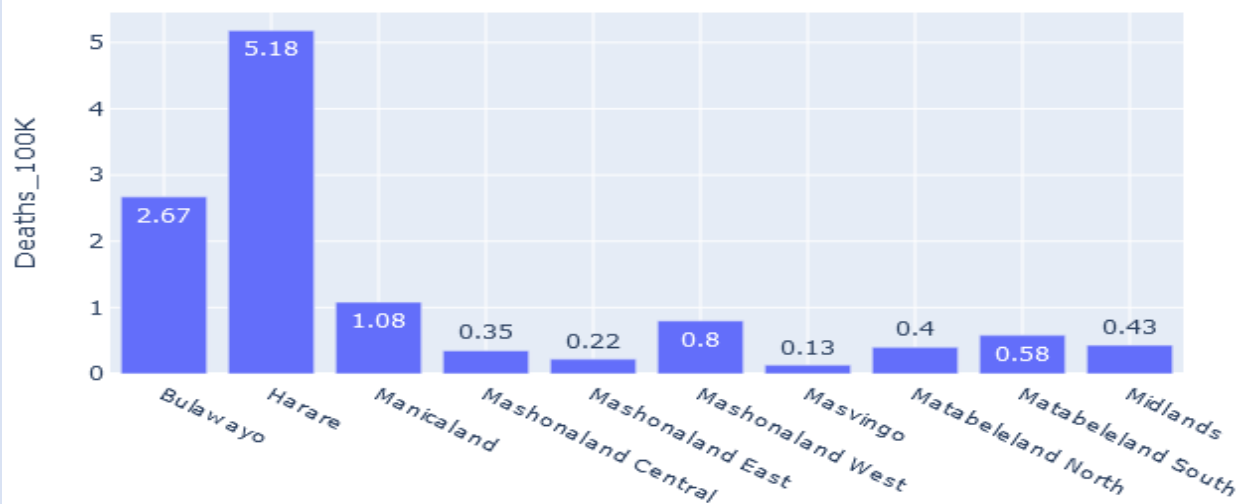

Zimbabwe Covid Cases Per 100K Popn

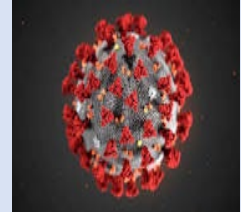


Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn



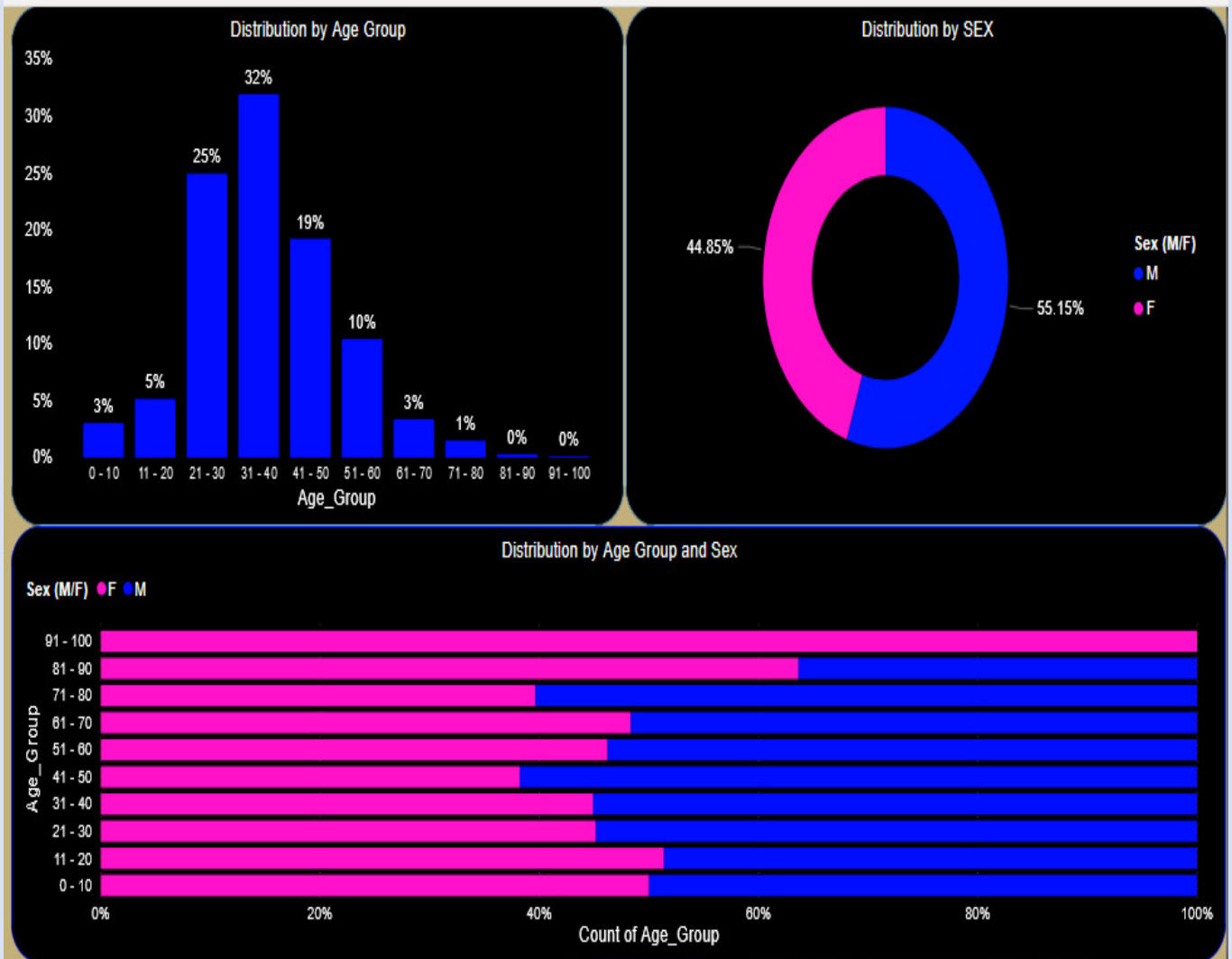
COMMENTS

- Harare has the highest number of deaths per capita followed by Bulawayo, Manicaland rising



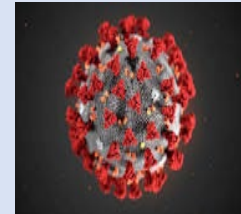

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



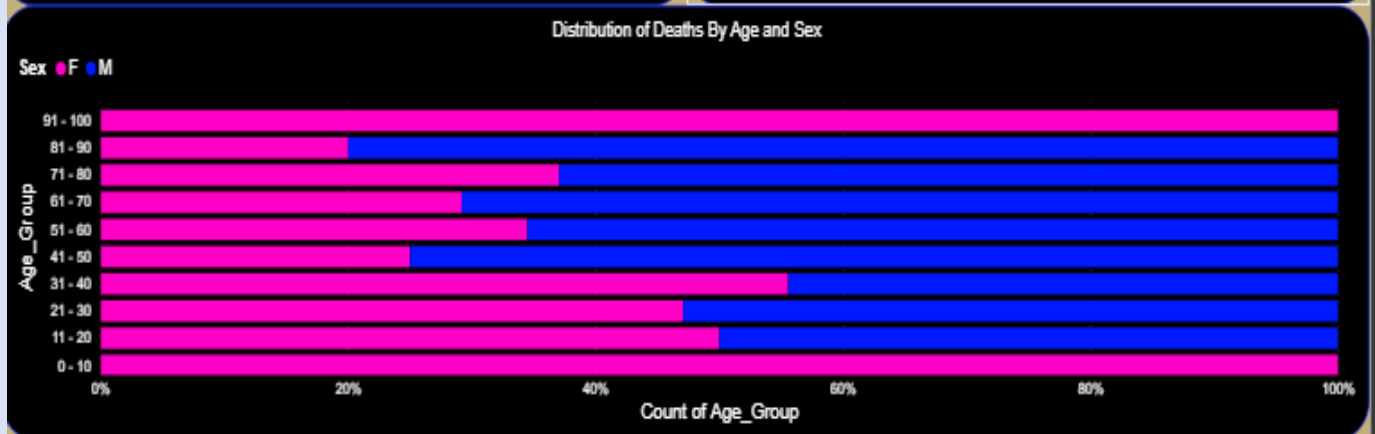
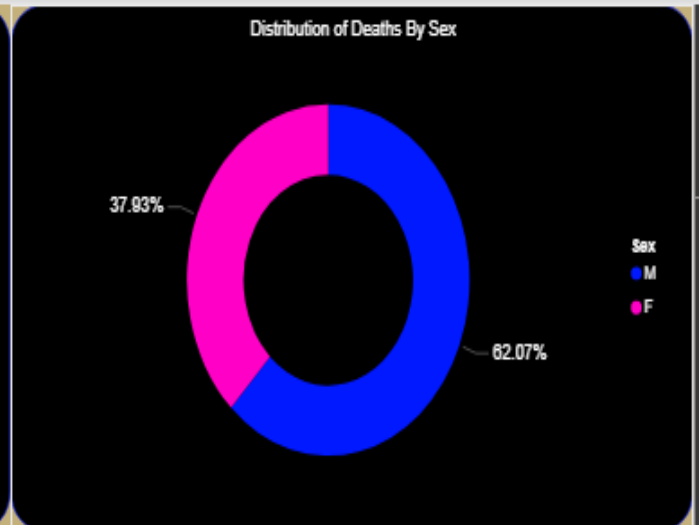
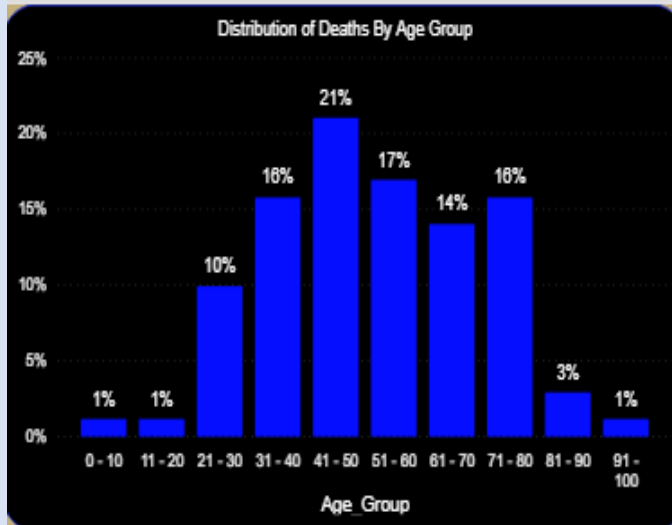
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths

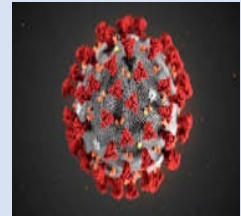

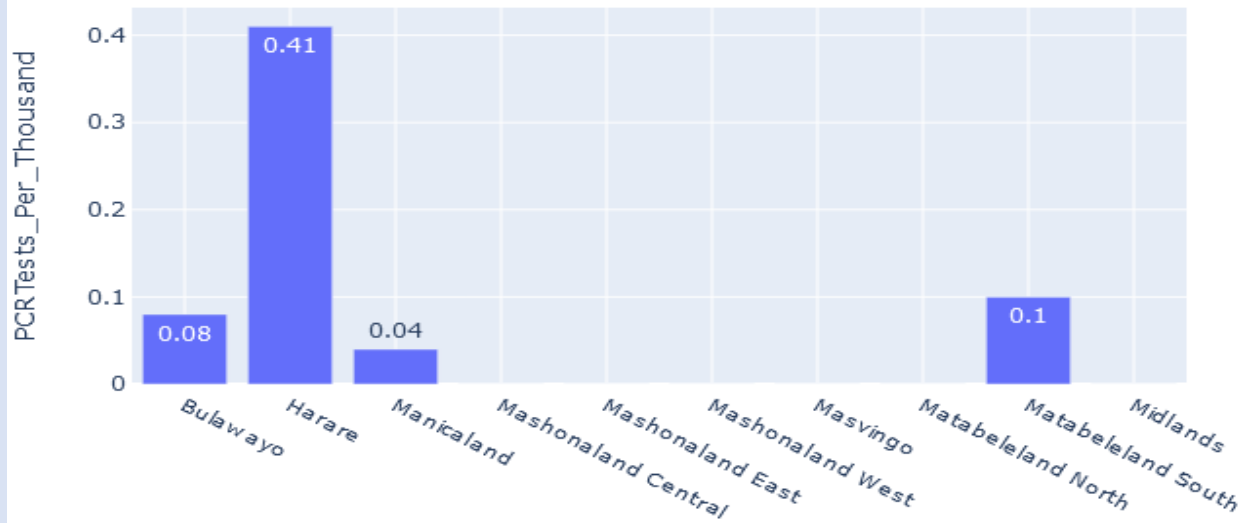
- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age (68%)

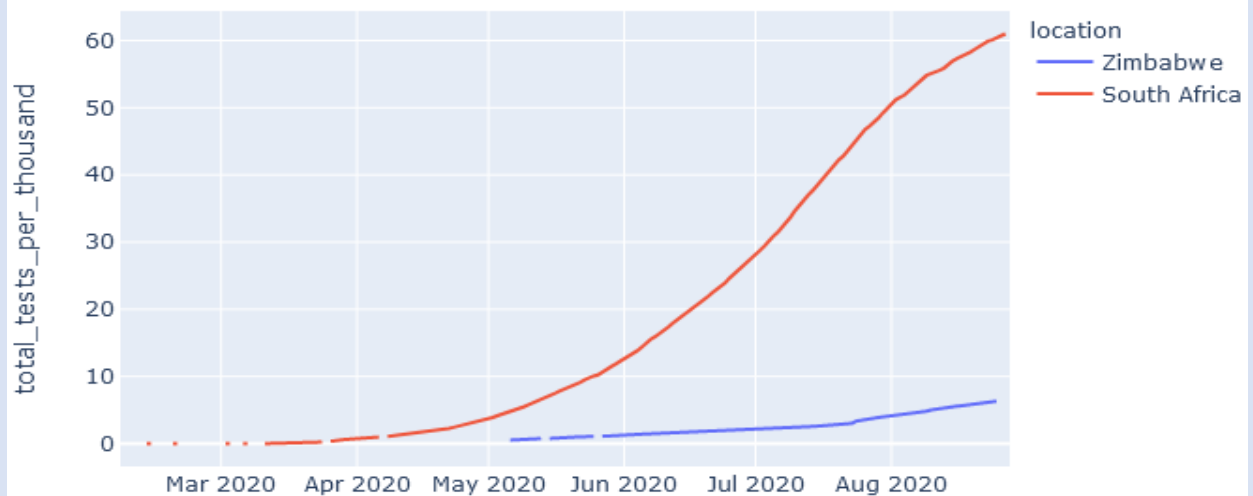


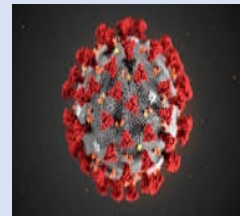
Number of PCR Tests done Per Thousand Population Today



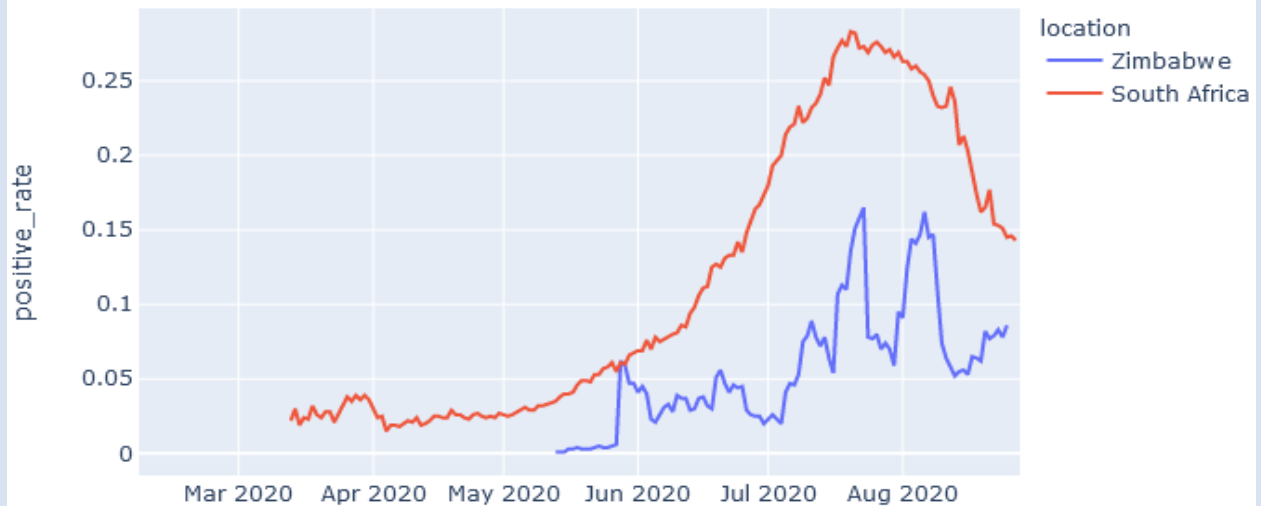

Covid-19 Positivity Zimbabwe and SA



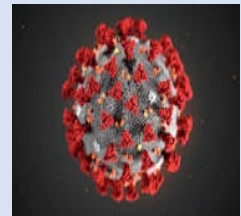
COMMENTS

- **Positivity has increased to 8.3%** (*targeted testing could account for this rise*)

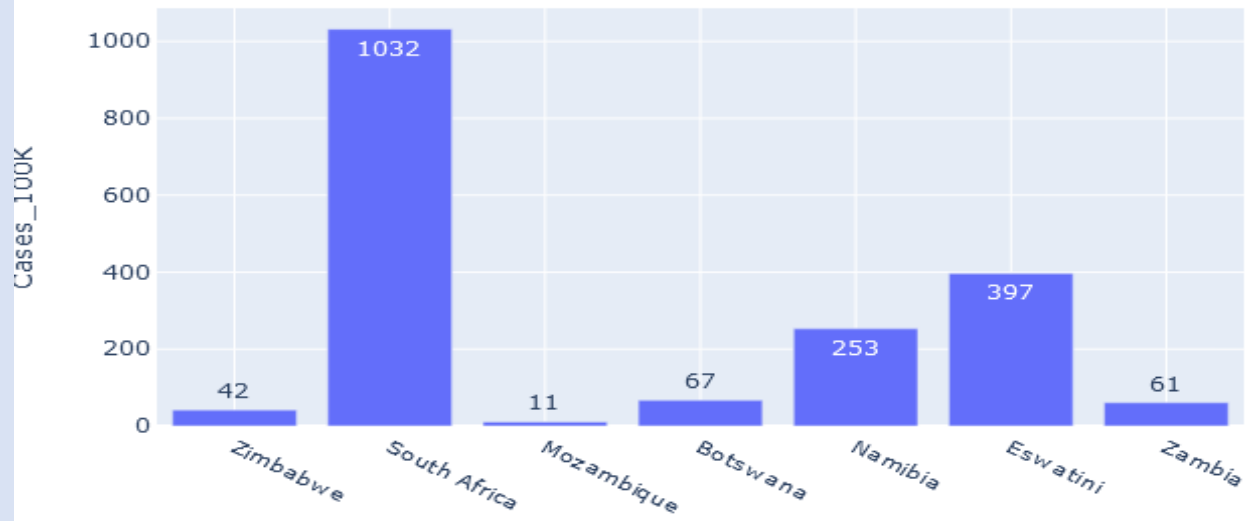

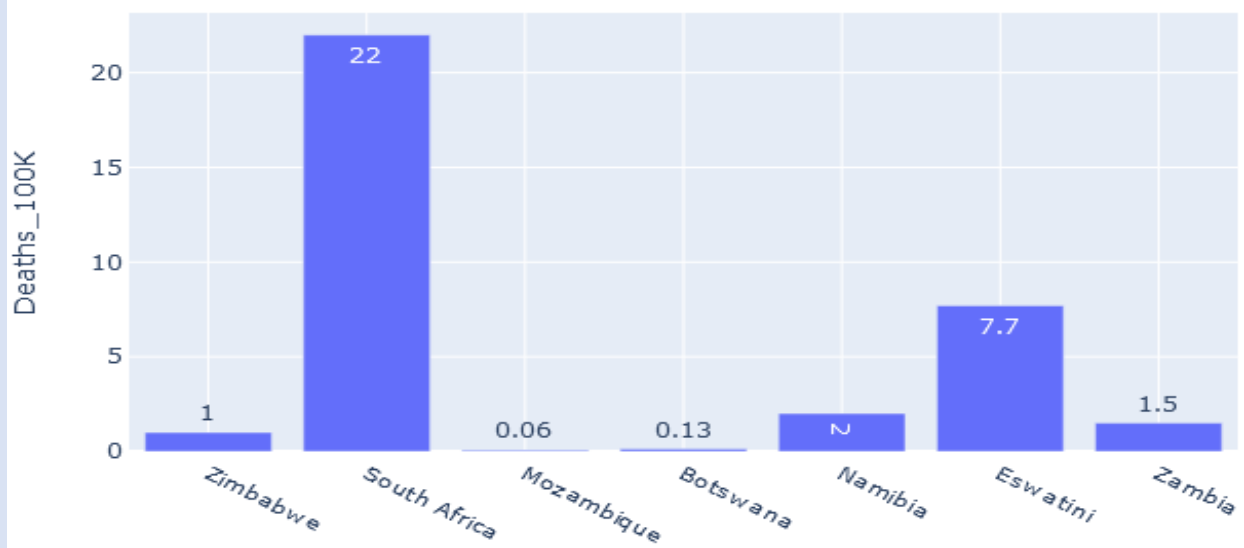
