



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 29/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 21 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases goes up to 18 from 16 yesterday).
- 467 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 4.5%)
- All 21 are local cases
- 10 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 78% and Active cases go up to 1487 today
- As of 29 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7837 Cases 6122 recoveries and 228 Deaths.









- Cumulative cases curve flattening

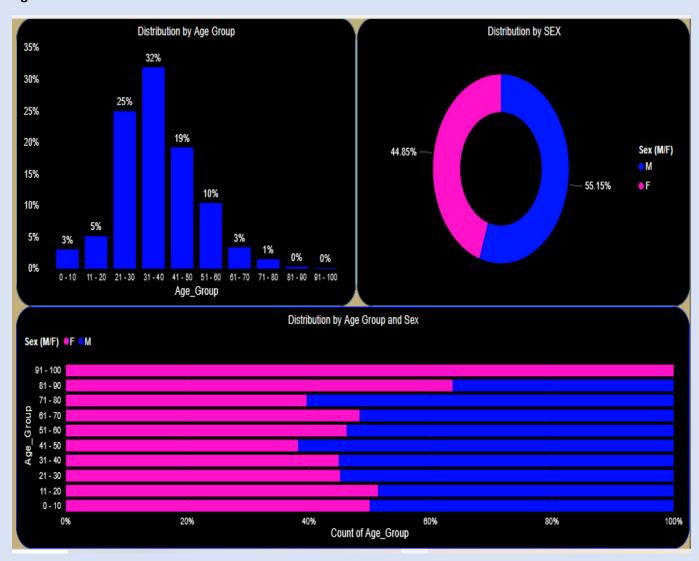
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises






