



Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 30/08/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- Only 6 New Cases and No Death reported in the last 24 hours.7 day rolling average for new cases has fallen from 200 at the beginning of August to 68 today.
- Much fewer tests (602) done today (But on a positive note positivity for today was 1%)
- All 6 are local cases and Active Cases go up to 1155 today
- 5 total new recoveries reported: All from Mash East: National Recovery rate still stands at 78.9%
- As of 30 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 6412 Cases 5061 recoveries and 196 Deaths.








Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases




Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate


- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend
- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at 3.1 % as at 30/8/20






Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn




COMMENTS

- Harare has the highest number of deaths per capita followed by Bulawayo and Manicaland






Age and Sex Distribution for Cases


- More males affected when compared to females

Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths




COMMENTS








Number of PCR Tests done Per Thousand Population Today



Covid-19 Positivity Zimbabwe and SA




COMMENTS

- Overall Positivity has increased to 8.3% (targeted testing could account for this rise)




