



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 30/11/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 84 New Cases and 1 Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases remains at 104).
- 797 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 10.5%)
- 61 are local cases while 23 are returnees from SA(22) and Botswana(1) (Death reported by Manicaland)
- 7 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 84.6% and Active cases go up to 1268 today
- As of 30 November 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 10 034 Cases 8489 recoveries and 277 Deaths.

CASES AND DEATHS DISTRIBUTION







Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate




- Cumulative cases curve spiking

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises







