



### Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 30/09/2020

#### **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- 1(local) New Case and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases goes down to 16 from 18 yesterday).
- 467 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 0.2%)
- The case was reported by Mat North Province
- 181 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate rises to 80% today and Active cases go down to 1307 today
- As of 30 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7838 Cases 6303 recoveries and 228 Deaths.






#### COMMENTS

# Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




#### COMMENTS

#### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases






- More males affected when compared to females


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)




